NOTICE OF WAIVER EXTENSION

Pursuant to Executive Orders 11-07 and 11-19, as Director of the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, I issued Notices on May 9, May 10, and June 23, 2011, temporarily waiving certain statutory and regularity requirements in order to best serve the interest of the public health and safety during the recovery period following the flooding events in southern Missouri. Such waivers apply in the counties of Butler, Wayne, Mississippi, Scott, Pemiscot, Dunklin, Carter, New Madrid, St. Francois, Stoddard, Cape Girardeau, Ripley, Reynolds, Howell, McDonald, Taney, Stone, Barry, Ozark, and other counties as deemed necessary by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources. Such waivers would expire on September 15, 2011, unless extended in whole or in part.

Pursuant to Executive Orders 11-09 and 11-19, as Director of the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, I issued Notices on May 23, May 26 and June 20, 2011, temporarily waiving certain statutory and regulatory requirements in order to best serve the interest of the public health and safety during the recovery period following the tornadoes and severe storm events that hit the cities of Joplin and Sedalia between May 22 and May 25, 2011. Such waivers apply in the counties of Newton, Jasper and Pettis, and any other counties affected by tornadoes and severe weather events occurring between May 22 and May 25, 2011. Such waivers would expire on September 15, 2011, unless extended in whole or in part.

Pursuant to Executive Order 11-23, I hereby extend such waivers until December 15, 2011, unless otherwise amended by subsequent notice, as stated in the Director's Notices dated May 9, May 10, May 23, May 26, June 20 and June 23, 2011.
