The crane operator was methodically dropping the wrecking ball through each floor near the support columns. Previous holes could be seen. This created very little dust, which generally stayed on the premises. It apparently weakened the structure and removed some of the concrete prior to section demolition. When school let out for the day, and the students were boarding their buses and/or heading home, the union operator and site supervisor for Premier Demolition (Jaime Chier) ceased work for the day to reduce the exposure of the students to any fugitive dust. He stated that inspectors from the City of St. Louis Building Division and Health Department stopped by occasionally to monitor the project. He showed me the fire hydrant that they were hooked up to at the NE corner of the site, and the Dust Boss® that creates an atomized mist that can be thrown a long distance.
