

## Permit Applicability Determination

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**Regulated Activities:** No construction permit is required if potential emissions of the entire installation are less than regulatory de minimis levels or potential emissions of the proposed project are below the insignificance levels. Rules outlined in 10 CSR 10-6.060 provide the authority for installations to construct and operate eligible modifications. Please be prepared to provide documentation of potential emission calculations when requested.

However, in certain instances, installations require written verification from the Air Pollution Control Program that the proposed modifications do not require a permit. In those instances, the documents listed in the Required Documents section may be submitted for review.

**Fees:** No filing fee (unless submitting an application). No review fees.

**Required Documents:** Documentation is not required for applicable sources unless written verification from the state is desired by the installation. In order to obtain written verification, the installation should submit a letter signed and dated by the responsible official outlining details of the proposed project. Information in the letter must include, but are not limited to, the following: maximum hourly design rates, raw material usage, equipment locations, and Material Data Safety Sheets.

If a determination cannot be made with the information submitted, the reviewing engineer may request an application be submitted for the proposed project for further review (for requirements, see Section (5) Permit Required). This action will not automatically require the installation to obtain a permit, but is necessary to allow the permitting engineer an opportunity to evaluate potential emissions more closely.

In order to avoid possible delays, an applicant may wish to forego the letter and submit an application for review for more complicated projects or if the potential emissions of a project are close to permitting thresholds (for requirements, see Section (5) Permit Required).

**Length of Permit:** There is no permit associated with this activity. A letter will be issued to the applicant stating the terms under which the no permit required determination was made.

**Pre-Construction Prohibition Waiver:** Not applicable.

**Processing Time:** Although there are no statutory time limits on permit applicability determination requests, these requests are processed in a timely manner. However, priority is given to formal permit applications. If further review of the project is required, an application must be submitted prior to construction of the proposed project.

**Pre-application Meetings:** None required.

**Public Participation:** None required
