RE: No Further Response Action Planned (NFRAP) - Areas of Concern (AOCs) A, C, and D

Dear Col. Thompson:

The Federal Facilities Section of the Hazardous Waste Program has received Gary L. Hinkle's request for approval of the No Further Response Action Planned (NFRAP) designation for AOCs A, C, and D, at the 157th Air Control Group, Jefferson Barracks Air National Guard Base (Jefferson Barracks), St. Louis, Missouri.

Our concurrence was based upon our review of the analytical data and findings from the following documents:

- 1.) The October 1994 Preliminary Assessment/Site Inspection Work Plan, received by the department on October 25, 1994.
- 2.) The April 1995 Draft PA/SI Report, received by the department September 18, 1995.
- 3.) The March 1996 Draft Phase I Environmental Baseline Survey, received by the department on August 13, 1996, with a five-page bibliography.
- 4.) The August 1996 Draft Final PA/SI, received by the department August 8, 1996.
- 5.) The March 1997 PA/SI Report, received by the department April 16, 2001.
- 6.) Operational Technologies Corporation (Op Tech) submitted satisfactory written responses to the written PA/SI comments we submitted (satisfactory, as clarified with 23 stakeholders at a meeting held October 29, 1996.)



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The department finds no additional investigation or remedial action is currently required with regard to hazardous substances. However, the department's finding is based solely on the information contained in these reports, and this finding does not constitute a certification or guarantee of the quality or the remedial action conducted or with regard to the lack of contamination on the property. In the event a future petroleum and/or solvent-related problem arises, the department reserves the right to require responsible parties to conduct additional investigation and/or remedial actions.

Mr. Gary L. Hinkle had also requested that we concur with a NFRAP decision on AOC B (now known as IRP Site No. 2). We were not able to grant this request. AOC B is presently the subject of a work plan for a remediation to be completed later this year.

When AOC B is fully characterized and remediated as needed, and when state regulatory concurrence is obtained, Jefferson Barracks Air National Guard Station will generate a Record of Decision. However, even then we reserve the right to require responsible parties to conduct additional investigations and/or remedial actions, should there be future findings related to past DOD activity.
