**Additional Information**



On 6/28/2012 at 2135 hours the EER 24-hour Spill Line received a call regarding a fire at a plating facility in Independence, MO. The Independence Fire Chief reported that the fire produced fire run-off water that entered a creek and then a dry catch basin. According to the fire chief the impacted creek does not support aquatic life and the catch basin or pond was lacking water. The catch basin is off-site of the plating facility. The plating facility is located at 10406 East 11th Street, and is known as Detray Plating. The Duty Officer could not reach any representatives from the facility.

Roarke Holzschuh/KCRO EER will mobilize to the site today and attempt to make contact with facility personnel, investigate any possible release from the run-off, and oversee any remediation needed.

Update SMC 6/29/12 1330hrs

KCRO called to notify that they would be collecting samples from the fire water runoff and or Criss Lake. Samples collected will be analyzed for metals, hexavalent chromium, and cyanide. The samples will be transported immediately to the State Environmental Laboratory in Jefferson City for analysis.

Detray has hired Waste Express as their primary waste disposal company. Waste Express had tapped Seneca Environmental to handle the bulk of the remediation work, however, it seems that Seneca did not have enough resources in the Kansas City area to handle the job and were not used. They instead hired Hazmat Response

Mr. Holzschuh said he was able to walk around the exterior of the facility. He was able to get only one good view of inside the facility and one of the open top chemical storage tanks, which had been overfilled with water from the fire.

Update SMC 6/26/12 1630 hrs

Andrea Collier (KCRO) notified the Spill Line that while KCRO staff was collecting samples at Criss Lake they noticed a fish kill near the where the drainage enters the lake. At this point it is a small kill of 25 fish, mostly minnows, a small bass and sunfish.

MDC has been notified, it appears that they had already visited the site earlier and left noting no fish kill. MDC personnel will remobilize to the site.

Roarke says that Hazmat Response is on site and beginning work.
