The Missouri Department of Natural Resources (Department) approves Lake City Army Ammunition Plant's (LCAAP) Class 1 Permit Modification request, dated November 12, 2012, without changes. The request was to amend portions of the *Resource Conservation and Recovery Act* Permit that are redundant or conflict with 40 CFR Part 63 Subpart EEE National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for hazardous waste combustors.

LCAAP must send a notice of the modification to everyone on their facility mailing list and the appropriate units of state and local government within 90 calendar days after the date of this letter, as outlined in Code of Federal Regulations 40 CFR 270.42(a)(1)(ii), incorporated by reference in Code of State Regulations 10 CSR 25-7.270(1), and modified by 10 CSR 25-7.270(2)(A)6 and 10 CSR 25-7.270(2)(B)10. LCAAP must send a copy of the notice to the Department.
