The Missouri Department of Natural Resources (Department) received Heritage Environmental Services, LLC's Class 1 Permit Modification notice, dated September 26, 2012. The notification was to update Section H – Preparedness and Prevention section of the permit application to reflect the installation of fire/smoke detectors in the truck unloading bay area located in the Process Building.

The Department agrees with Heritage Environmental Services, LLC, that this is a Class 1 Permit Modification not requiring prior director approval. Heritage Environmental Services, LLC, already sent a notice of the modification to everyone on their facility mailing list and the appropriate units of state and local government within 90 calendar days after the change was put into effect, as outlined in Code of Federal Regulations 40 CFR 270.42(a)(1)(ii), incorporated by reference in Code of State Regulations 10 CSR 25-7.270(1). On October 1, 2012, the Department received a copy of the notice, dated September 26, 2012.
