Comments: The UAA survey was conducted in May 2008 and no WBCR was observed. An interview with an adjacent land owner cites both observed and personal fishing and swimming use on the creek. ATV tracks were noted near the stream at site 4, and footprints were documented at site 8.

Is the evaluated use attainable? Yes No


Comments: The stream met the maximum depth criterion at 8 out of 11 sites evaluated, and met the median depth criterion at 2 out of 11 sites. Due to the stream meeting these depth criteria, and the documented existing use, the committee recommends the WBCR use designation be retained. Due to documented evidence of secondary contact, the committee recommends the Secondary Contact Recreation use be assigned.
