Comments: The UAA survey was conducted in September 2008 and no WBCR was observed. No interviews were conducted during this survey and no comments were received in 2008. SCR use (fishing, wading and boating) were noted in the 2005 UAA.

Comments: The stream did meet the maximum depth criteria as well as the median depth at one site location. No interviews or comments were made in 2008. The committee recommends that this water body retain use for WBCR. The committee also recommends that SCR use be added based on 2005 comments.
