Comments: The UAA survey was conducted in September 2008 and no evidence of WBCR observed. A 2005 comment stated swimming occurs on this stream. The 2008 UAA noted a footpath leading to the stream. No interviews were conducted during the 2008 UAA.

Is the evaluated use attainable? Yes No

Comments: The stream met the maximum depth criterion at 2 of 4 sites. Because the maximum depth criterion was met and swimming is an existing use, the committee recommends that the WBCR use be retained. Due to evidence of secondary contact recreation (footpath), the committee recommends that the secondary contact recreation use be assigned..
