Comments: The UAA survey was conducted in May 2008 and no WBCR was observed, however a rope swing was observed. A 2005 UAA received comments citing swimming, fishing and wading as uses occurring on this stream. No interviews were conducted.

Is the evaluated use attainable? Yes No

Comments: The stream met the maximum depth criterion at 2 of 3 sites and the median depth criterion at 1 of 3 sites. Because the depth criteria were met and there is evidence WBCR is an existing use, the committee recommends that the WBCR use be added. Due to comments citing secondary contact recreation (fishing and wading) the committee recommends the secondary contact recreation use be assigned.
