Is the evaluated use attainable? Yes No

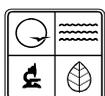
Comments: A formal UAA study was not conducted and no depth measurements were made. However, due to multiple comments citing existing WBCR use, the committee recommends that this segment be classified and the WBCR use designation be added. Due to multiple comments citing SCR use, the committee recommends that the SCR use be assigned. Because these uses are consistent with the classified, downstream segment, WBID 2393, the committee recommends extending the classified segment upstream to include the areas where the existing uses are occurring.
