Comments: The UAA survey was conducted in October 2008 and no evidence of WBCR was observed. No interviews were conducted.

Is the evaluated use attainable? Yes No
Comments: The stream did not meet the maximum or median depth criteria during the 2008 UAA survey. However, a 2005 UAA found the stream to be meeting the maximum depth criterion. Because the maximum depth criterion has been met, the committee recommends that the WBCR use designation be retained.
