Emissions Reporting Proposal

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Summary of Emissions Reporting Proposal

- Facility submits throughput/emissions data by March 1
- Air Program staff calculates emissions/fees using MoEIS
- Facility receives an invoice by May 1
- Deadline for paying emission fees is June 1 (no change)

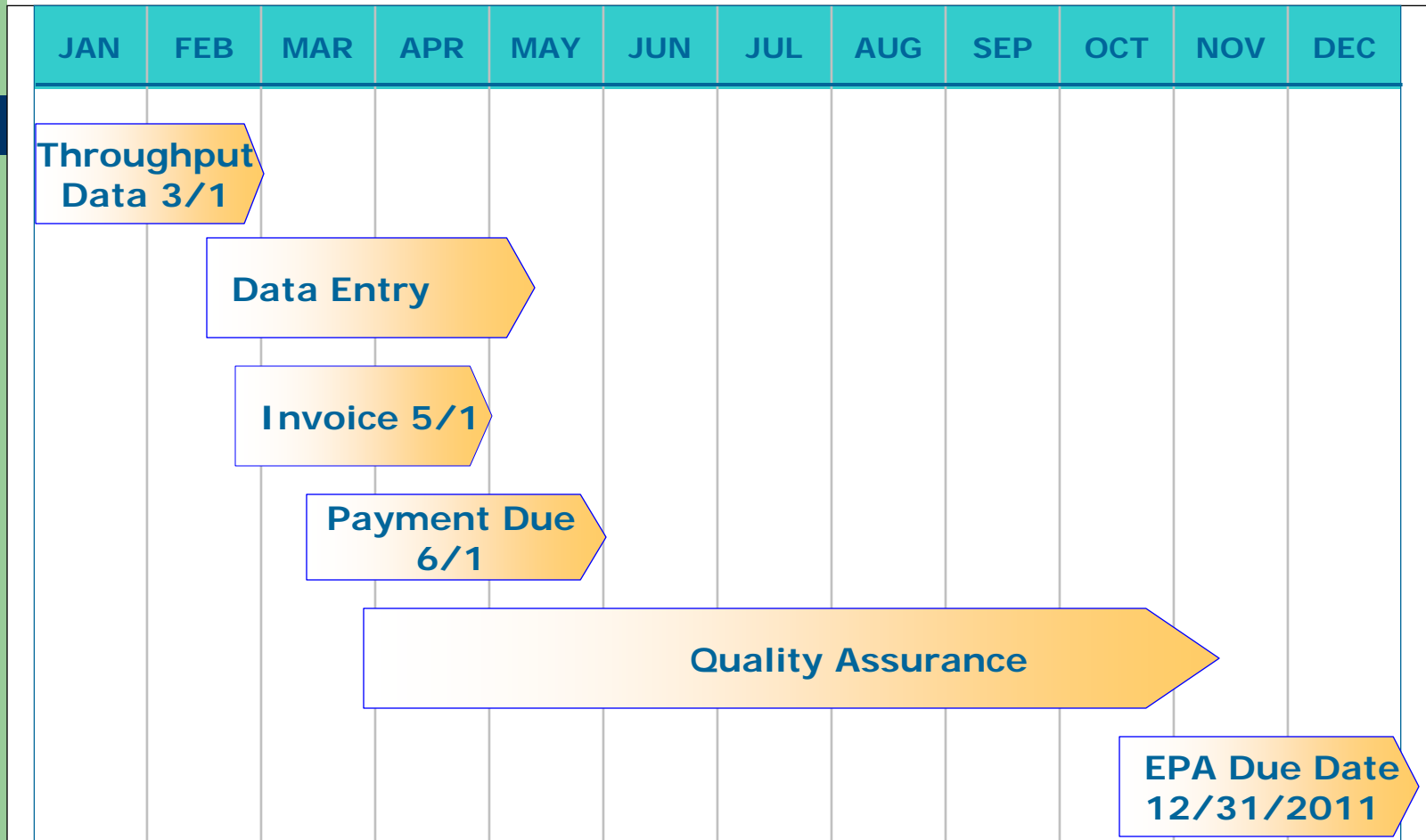
New EPA Emissions Reporting Rule (AERR)

- Changes deadline for submitting data to EPA's National Emissions Inventory (NEI) – 6 months following June 1 rather than 12 months
- Increases number of facilities submitted to NEI – reporting thresholds based on potential rather than actual emissions

Emission Thresholds & Number of Facilities for Reporting to NEI

- **Part 70 & Intermediate sources submitted annually**
 - PTE \geq 100 TPY SO₂, NO_x, CO, VOC, PM₁₀, PM_{2.5}, or NH₃
 - PTE \geq 5 TPY Lead
(50~100 vs. 300~600)
- **Basic & NOP sources submitted every 3 years**
 - PTE \geq De minimis
(~2200)

Proposed Emissions Reporting 2010 Data



Benefits of Proposed Process

- Maintains consistency of emissions calculations
- Saves time and money
- Reduces errors and guesswork
- Creates greater transparency and certainty in emission fees due
