Comments I explained to the caller that the Department of Natural Resources does not regulate smoking meat. I also explained that due to regulation changes, residential burning of wood and household trash is not restricted by the Department and may be regulated on a city or county level. I also recommend that if he thinks the piles of wood are a fire hazard that he should contact his local fire department. The caller stated he would probably contact his city council regarding the smoking and burning. Note, it appears the address for this concern may actually be 119 Lakeview Drive based on online property records, but the caller stated it as 198 Lakeview Drive and that is what is listed in other concerns about this location. I observed several burn barrels but nothing out c ordinary. I did observe what looked like a fairly recent burn pile in a yard adjacent to L&J Home Repairs. The burn spot is located in the Northeast cori lot at the intersection of Z and J HW. It looks like the fire might have come into contact with the trees that were next to it (pictures below). I spoke with Lee Lowman via phone on 03/27/2020 and inquired about any open burning in the area. He stated that he has not open burned since the time we had talked (aside from his burn barrel). Lee stated that he believed the burn pile I located was his neighbors. Lee stated that they had burned some tree limbs and added some household trash to the pile as well. Lee stated that there may have been some very old rail road ties in the pile as w from when the neighbor bought the house some years ago. Lee stated that he was too late to let them know to not burn those if they were already in t pile this time. I went over the open burning regulations with Lee again, even though this incident does not directly involve him.

I am sending this email for a open burning trash issue that I called the Phelps County Sheriff dispatch about on Saturday afternoon of March 7th. The officer that came out called me after talking to the person doing the burning (the office was Za Macey). I asked the officer if he was going to do anything and he said that you are allowed to burn on your own property. I told the officer that the person that owns the lot has a no dumping sign on the lot but he said the person said he had permission to do the burning. The reason I had called in the first place is because my wife and I were heading into town and saw the person that was dropping off more trash. The picture with the blue tarp is what was burning when the officer showed up and the person doing the burning had another truck load besides that pile.

I have copied the open burning law for the state of Missouri DNR for your reference, and also a link to some pictures of the trash that they have been burning all week long. I think they have only missed two days this week of burning. If you would like to call for any reason please do.

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Comments	<p>On March 20, 2020, I travelled to the location described in this environmental concern. There was no one at the site. I took photographs from off property to document what I saw. It did look like some open burning had been taking place. There was an apparent gasoline container on site and an apparent burn area.</p> <p>I tried unsuccessfully to reach the alleged responsible party for some time.</p> <p>I telephoned the concerned party, Samuel Auxier on March 24, 2020. He stated that the open burning was happening frequently and that he was afraid that a flood would wash the burn debris into the Dry Fork River and eventually it would end up in the Meramec River.</p> <p>I received a telephone call from Herbert Bone. He stated that he had never open burned on a property on County Road 3620. He has only open burned some brush piles on his property at 15840 County Road 2370 in St. James.</p> <p>I sent Herbert Bone a copy of the regulation 10 Code of State regulations 10-6.045 Open Burning Requirements and the fact sheet Facts on Open Burning Under Missouri Regulations.</p> <p>Insufficient evidence was found to determine that a violation had occurred and to discover the responsible party.</p>

	<p>Comments On 3/29/2020, during a non-work related recreational drive around Cuivre River State Park, I observed a large number of pallets stacked in a manner consistent with a burn pile and recalled that this was the same location as a 2017 solid waste concern. I saw no signs of open burning and observed that all of the material behind the shop that I observed in 2017 was no longer there.</p> <p>On 4/2/2020, I verified property ownership, reviewed aerial photos of the concern site, and reviewed the complaint folder. I confirmed that I conducted solid waste concern investigation at the same property on 5/30/2017. During my 2017 investigation, I observed numerous pallets and tarps that appeared to be placed to function as a fence behind a shop on the property.</p> <p>During another non-work related recreational drive around Cuivre River State Park on 4/6/2020, I saw that the burn pile observed the week before had been burned and was actively smoldering with a small amount of smoke.</p> <p>On 4/7/2020, I left a phone message with the concerned party requesting a call back.
