Mr. Falkenrath stated that he does not burn treated lumber or waste oil. (His recycling business does have a large outside furnace that he burns untreated pallet wood wastes for comfort heat). He did state that when he was away from the business on vacation in May of 2012, that one of his employees did cause a fire that destroyed some of his recyclables. He stated that he is still disposing of this waste to the Phelps County Transfer Station as time, money and weather allows. The following issues with his outside storage were observed and discussed with Mr. Falkenrath. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I observed 4 large truck batteries that were damaged by fire. - I observed an area (approximately 40 ft. length X approximately 20 ft. wide X 8 ft. tall = of mixed wood wastes that appeared to have lost their value. - I observed a large area of waste pallets and other types of wood wastes that appeared to have lost their value. <p>The following steps were discussed with Mr. Falkenrath to address the recyclables that no longer have value and require proper disposal.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Immediately take steps to properly dispose of the batteries. - By June 5, 2013, properly dispose of the approximately 235 cu. yards of mixed wood wastes. - By September 5, 2013, properly dispose of the pallets and other types of wood wastes that have lost their recyclable value. - Immediately take steps to insure that solid wastes (waste particle board and plywood) are source separated and properly disposed of and not combined with from other mixed woods that may have a recycling value. - Continue to take steps to properly dispose of any burned recyclables from last May's fire. - To verify that Recycle Works LLC operates as a recycling business, by April 5, 2013, please submit to this office a print out of all of the volume and/or weights of recyclable materials brought to your recycling site; the weights of each recyclables delivery to a recycling facility, and receipts from any permitted solid waste processing and/or landfill for the recyclables that have lost their value and were properly disposed of. The bees wings are larger than the 100 micrometers of aerodynamic diameter necessary to meet the definition of particulate matter regulated in the Rules of Department of Natural Resources 10 Code of State Regulations 10-6.170: Restriction of Particulate Matter to the Ambient Air Beyond the Premises of Origin and defined at 10 Code of State Regulations 10-6.020: "Definitions and Common Reference Tables." Therefore, the bees wings are not regulated as particulate matter, but are exempted. In general, when complaints are generated by corn handling, bees wings are involved.</p>
