They have been cutting the chutes off the side of the building, causing fiberglass residue to accumulate on vehicles of nearby businesses and causing white powder to become airborne. The concerns about this are: The CP is a business owner of a nearby business. Expensive equipment as well as the health of employees and business owners at nearby businesses (the PM is accumulating on surfaces at the CP's shop, a machine shop and possibly a detail shop). He worked outside yesterday and now has a sore throat and voice. He believes this may have been caused by breathing the particulate matter.
