Comments The building burned the night of June 4-5. I spoke by telephone with Mr. Mike Ward, (417) 855-0006, Volunteer Fireman for the city of Willow Springs today. He responded about midnight on the night of the fire and he lives behind the property. He saw that the large building had been knocked down with a trackhoe and pushed into the foundation and "pyramided" up. He saw that it was burning all over, meaning that it had been lit all around. He could smell diesel fuel and saw a trailer with a tank of diesel fuel nearby. He wasn't sure if diesel was used as an accelerant. The equipment had been pulled away from the fire. He estimated the building at 40' x 60'. He said he could not be sure if Mr. Harris set the fire, but it probably saved him paying for the disposal of 10 loads of demolition waste.

I spoke with Doug Cunningham, (870) 371-0571, 1035 Republican Road, Salem, AR, 72576 on Tuesday June 11th at the site and he said that he did not burn or demolish the building. The wastes were still burning (see photos). In the second photo there is a large tree trunk in the burning debris. Why would that be there? Mr. Cunningham said that it was arson and tha the building was probably 80' x 35' single story. He said he was hired to repair and upgrade a metal building on the site. That appeared to be what he was doing. He asked me to contact Mr. Joe Harris, 4335 Co. Rd. 7200, West Plains, MO 65775, the property owner.

I met with Mr. Harris (417)257-0844 or (417) 257-5128 (cell) the same day and he adamantly denied burning the building and named two individuals with vendettas that he said were at the burn site on Tuesday. He said his equipment was parked too close to the building and he was lucky that they weren't damaged or destroyed by the fire. He said that he intended to haul the building to the transfer station, but now he will have to deal with nails that could ruin expensive tires on his equipment. He plans to put in another salvage yard at that location. He owns several, including West 160 Salvage near West Plains. His property address is 3768 Private Road 1271. The property is owned by Joe Leon Harris, Jr. and Jennifer Lynn Harris and they are/were(?) buying it from Noble Grogan and Chari Lynn Groigan 108 West 10th Street, Willow Springs, MO as a contract for deed. Mr. Harris said the building was once a school and was later used as a flea market.

I called Hillbilly Junction and left a message for the owner to call me on 6-12-13. To date he has not called me back. The manager said that they knew it would be burned and that the owner had discussed with her that he was concerned the ash would land on the roof of his business and start a fire. I suspect that the owner of Hillbilly Junction is the anonymous concerned party. This person adamantly did not want me to know who he was, so if I am correct, I doubt he will call me back.
