**Comments** Two Notices of Violation were issued to David Landes: Notice of Violation #KCR2013020116245904 for burning a large quantity of demolition debris in a residential area, and Notice of Violation #KCR2013020116546084 for failure to submit notification and conduct asbestos inspection. Notice of Violation #KCR2013021113414926 was issued to Brian Nail and Nail Excavating for failure to submit notification and conduct asbestos inspection. In 2009, Mr. Nail received Notice of Violation #KCR2009062213094734 (for demolishing the building directly across the street from this grain elevator without having an asbestos inspecton performed or submitting the required notification) and Notice of Violation #2009062213454950 (for burning the demolition debris of the same building).

**Comp. No.** 14299      **Comp. Info.** Via email, "I took an anonymous call this morning which reported demolition of a grain elevator in Jamesport at the former Kauffman and Reed facility. The caller said that demolition has been taking place for about a week. The caller was concerned that the facility had not been inspected for asbestos prior to demolition. Also, the caller said that on January 1 the contractor was burning wood waste from the demolition. They said that likely the waste is still burning. Two more grain bins are left to be demolished. They have removed the grain legs and headhouse."

"They report that the facility being demolished is no longer owned by Kauffman and Reed (the caller did not know the name of the new owner). It is being demolished by Mail Excavating of Gallatin, MO."

"I provided them with your office telephone number and said that Daviess County was your jurisdiction. They asked us to pass along the information to you."

CP is out of town but requests that DNR contact him in advance so his daughter can meet them on site. There are 3 complaints: 1. Neighbor burns horse manure at night. The burning causes a very thick smoke and a terrible odor. About 1 month ago, a large pile of manure, brush and lumber/flatboards were burned during high winds. The CP contacted the local police and fire departments, who responded to the scene. Sparked high into the night. The Fire Department told them he would turn them in and they spent several days with a backhoe destroying the evidence and burying everthing in a homemade landfill. 2. There are so many animals on the neighbor's property that the odor makes it so CP cannot sit on their deck. I told him that DNR doesn't regulate animals, but he said he wants something done about the odor. 3. They built a private landfill where they disposed of the old septic system, plastic buckets, horse manure and other debris. The runoff from the neighbor's landfill flowed into pond owned by CP. CP states his pond is ruined due to runoff from the neighbor's property, same runoff also goes to Smithville Lake.
