Mr. Knoll passed away last year and the property was divided in two. CP purchased half of the property this past fall and has noticed a putrid smell from the back property when cutting the brush. CP states that one of the former workers for Mr. Knoll told him that the rotten corn gluten was dumped into a pond on the property which turned the water black, sludge-like, and putrid. Last summer, they cut a dike on the pond and let the rancid water pour out (CP called it sludge), which then entered CP's property. He's not sure if anyone has been informed at DNR but he didn't think that this was a normal process. He's more than willing to help the inspector assigned to this.

Concern No.	26091	Concern Info	While departing Sedalia Monday, February 15, 2016, via North Ohio Avenue, I observed on the west side of the road a technician sandblasting a metal rack or large part in the open area behind the company building. The technician appeared to be wearing a protective suit and helmet. The blasting dust appeared to be piled 2-3ft high which may indicate that the process has been ongoing.					
Comments	<p>I did not stop and make contact with the company.</p> <p>Fugitive dust was observed leaving the site. No concerns have been made against the facility, and the facility plans to start construction in March on a building to house sandblasting activities. A letter of warning will be issued requesting a compliance plan to resolve fugitive dust.</p> <p>On February 23, 2016, I responded to the above concern. Upon arrival to 1505 Ohio Ave, there was a worker outside sandblasting a metal frame. I observed fugitive dust leaving the property boundary to the south where there is a tree trimming and wood chipping business next door to the facility. No one was available at the tree trimming business.</p> <p>I spoke with John Cornell, manager of Sure Coat. I explained my visit. I asked if they always sandblast outside, and he said yes. I told him that fugitive dust from the sand blasting was leaving their property boundary, and I asked if they planned on moving the process inside the building. Mr. Cornell told me that they were going to start building construction for the sandblasting either the beginning or toward the end of March. I suggested that before they start construction on the building that they contact APCP permitting to make sure they don't need a dust collection system.</p> <p>I asked if he had a permit for storm water or if any inspector from water had been out to the facility. He told me that waste water was out there and that there was no toxins in the water. I saw no indication of run off toward Ohio Ave.</p>

Concern No.	26188	Concern Info	I received a call this afternoon from Larry Bigus with Central Platte Fire Protection District. Someone within the district called him about her neighbor burning trash. He did not get her name, but her phone number is 816-225-0289 and she lives at 15151 Kirk Avenue. The person burning lives at 15191 Kirk Avenue.					
Comments	<p>An on-site investigation was attempted, but the property owner was not home. The property owner was later contacted by telephone. The property owner denied open burning, but a burn barrel was observed from the highway. An LOW will be issued to formally advise the property owner of the burning regulations, including the prohibition from burning residential waste in a non-agriculturally zoned area of Platte County.</p> <p>An on-site investigation will be conducted if further concerns are received.</p> <p>On 2/17/2016 at 1:15pm I called the CP. She stated that the RP burns all their household waste in a burn barrel in the back yard. She stated that the RP does not set trash out for the city to collect any longer. The burning used to only occur at night, but recently has been occurring in the afternoon, between 3-5pm. CP believes the last burn took place on 2/11/16 or 2/12/16, and occurs once a week on average. CP stated that the neighborhood they are located in is outside of city limits, but is not zoned for agricultural use. CP stated that the fire department told her that they would not be responding to the trash fire. CP asked me to explain the open burning regulation to her, because the information she found on the website was slightly confusing. I did so, and also offered to email her the information as well. I told her I would be responding to the concern on 2/18/16. CP stated that there are several people living at the RP address, and she is not sure if they are home during the day or not.</p> <p>On February 18, 2016, at 12:30 p.m., I arrived at the RP address. I knocked on the front door. There were dogs barking behind the door; I waited a few minutes, and there was no answer. I left factsheets (PUB02047, PUB2070), a copy of the regulation, and my business card with a note to call me in the door. I proceeded to the CP's address; I gave an update on the situation, let them know that no one was home but that I left information in the door. I told CP I would be trying to find a phone number for the RP, and if I did not hear from them I would revisit the site. I told CP to let me know if burning continues before she hears from me. CP stated that the RP had cleaned up the area some since she called the fire department. I told CP I would follow-up as information came available.</p> <p>On February 19, 2016, at 1:10 p.m., I received a voicemail from a woman stating she was calling in regards to a business card left in her doorway. She did not leave a name.</p> <p>On February 23, 2016, I received an email from CP stating that the RP had burned trash on Sunday afternoon.</p> <p>On February 24, 2016, I returned RP call. There was no answer, but her recording said her name was Michelle Hancock. I left a voicemail.</p> <p>On February 24, 2016, at 11:15 a.m., Ms. Hancock called me back. I went over the information I left with her in detail and explained the regulations and requirements to her. She would not admit to burning residential waste in the back yard. I told her I was going to issue a Letter of Warning (LOW). I told her that because we received a concern about the burning, it is likely that if they continue to burn we will receive more concerns. She asked me why the zoning of agriculture vs. residential would make a difference in what they could burn. I explained that the rule was written that way to protect the respiratory health of people living in populated areas, i.e. neighborhoods like the one she lived in. After our phone conversation, I emailed the CP to let her know I would be issuing an LOW and to please let us know if the burning continues. RP confirmed she was the property owner, and confirmed mailing address.</p>

Mr. Norcross performed an air source inspection of the facility on the same date. We learned that the facility's new director and superintendent are being pro-active in bringing the facility out of dis-repair. The digesters have not been cleaned in over 15 years, the incinerator will be replaced, and other maintenance will be performed on equipment.								
I called the concerned party and gave them an update on what we found out, and I told her to call again if the odor comes back

Comments	No evidence of renovation or demolition was observed. Mr. Terry was informed of the asbestos requirements. No violations were noticed during the investigation.							
I arrived in Rich Hill and went to the city hall. I met with Christopher Foster, who is the Emergency Management Director for the city. He was aware of the building and was able to take me to it. We discussed what was happening with that building. He told me that no work had been done on the building so far. A stage 1 environmental assessment had been conducted on the building. I told him that before any work was to be conducted that the owner needed to have an asbestos inspection done on the building and to send in a NESHAP notification for demo/reno. He told me that he would ensure that this was done.								
I talked to Mr. Joe Terry, the owner of the building, on March 9, 2016. He confirmed that no work had been done on the building. He assured me that all the proper steps would be taken before any demo or renovation was conducted. The city was on him about getting the building tore down and is pressuring him to do so. He told the city that he had to go through the proper steps before any work could be done.

As the smoke proceeded to permeate throughout my residence clearly many hundred yards away I was concerned for the welfare of my 4 children due to them inhaling the asbestos in the smoke. At which time I took it upon myself to contact a friend at the local fire department and ask him if there was anything I could do about this hazardous situation. He called his dispatch and the fire marshal along with local personal showed up in a matter of minutes. The trucks put out the fire and they were required to cover up the remains. This morning Feb 6, 2016 upon arriving home from my children's activities I again witnessed them finishing the demo of this home. They obviously didn't heed the counsel from the local fire marshal as they were loading up the asbestos material and hauling it to now a different field. I fear that this asbestos material because it wasn't properly disposed of not only poses a risk to my family and I because of the smoke inhalation when they were burning it but possibly to our water supply as well since they are burning it so close to our property. We chose not to press charges this first time but because the property owner has clearly no remorse for his actions I am filing this complaint. Today Feb 13th he has started again to haul off the rest of the home. I have taken pictures of him loading it and hauling it into the field to burn. Although the pictures I tried to take of the fire didn't turn out since I was to far away and it was 8 pm and dark outside. I do however have a few of the smoldering ashes he is stirring with his skids-tear. This is even more disturbing that no local law enforcement has taken further action due to the fact that there is a burn ban in effect in Newton County at this time.
