He was concerned that he (and others) had been exposed to friable asbestos materials on at least 3 occasions: •Project 1: They were required to remove 9X9 floor tile from a 12X12 sized room and the tile was being extensively broken up during the project. He became concerned and apparently contacted the school safety coordinator, who he said sent in a sample for analysis and it came back positive. •Project 2: They were required to remove mastic from a 30X30 bathroom and were doing so with a buffer with abrasive pad. He again became concerned and the safety coordinator again sampled and results were positive. •Project 3: They were working in a gymnasium and required to saw through some board which he characterized as a transite type of material, and they were working in "clouds of dust." Same concerns, same result; i.e., +for asbestos. He said that the university does not provide any PPE when they do these projects, does not know beforehand whether ACM is involved, and basically blows him off when he raises concerns with them. He contacted OSHA but was told that as a governmental facility they couldn't do anything.					
Comments	The university had some recent renovations where non-friable asbestos material was rendered friable; however, it appears that the amount of regulated asbestos containing material produced remained below the regulatory thresholds. There are two root causes for these incidents: 1) not having a written scope of work in order for the health and safety manager to know what facility components will be altered and 2) workers performing unapproved work. After these incidents and before my investigation, the university had already taken action to remedy this situation. A detailed written scope of work will be required before any work, and workers will face disciplinary actions for conducted work outside of the scope of work without getting approval.
