He was calling for someone else who had seen what he considered to irregular asbestos removal. He stated that there was asbestos pipe insulation in the building that workers for Advanced Environmental Services, Inc out of St. Louis were removing. A neighbor of the building stated that the workers were in street clothes and windows were open during the removal. I explained that the removal may be confined to the basement area and the workers would not wear PPE outside. He said that they were going to remove transite windows soon. I asked if he had noticed any asbestos waste being improperly disposed and he stated that he has driven by the building but did not see any. The building is unoccupied." "Mr. Impey has previously contacted the agency with a complaint. The Houston School District contacted me as well because their asbestos inspections had lapsed. The school district said that they were going to resolve the issue. Let me know if you have any questions. THANKS!"					
Comments	On 6/30/16 I investigated this asbestos abatement project concern. There was only maintenance personnel at the school at the time of investigation. All other staff would return on July 5th. I returned on 7/5/16 and spoke with Mr. Alan Moss, the new Superintendent of the Houston R-1 School District. Mr. Moss had just started his position on 7/5/16 and wasn't very familiar with the abatement. I also spoke with the maintenance supervisor and he stated that AG Environmental was very professional with the containment areas, decon unit, enclosed trailer, etc. He stated that they removed insulation from some pipes, tile and some window panels. They also ran water from the adjacent administration building for their water supply. The building has been vacant since 2008 as it has a serious mold hazard. I then spoke with Mr. Bryan Giffin, of AG Environmental on 7/7/16 about the abatement and of this concern. He stated that they had four separate work areas and they had to clean the gym area to construct the decon unit as the entire building was contaminated with mold. Otherwise, it sounded as if abatement continued as normal. I was not at the building during abatement activities. However, after speaking with staff from the school and the contractor, it appears that abatement was performed per the NESHAP regulations. I have attached a copy of the post notification and receipts of disposal. This contractor has been in the industry for several years and does not have a history of noncompliance. No further action required on this concern by this inspector at this time.

Comments	<p>On July 14, 2016, I accompanied Rick Pretz and Art Goodin during a multimedia concern investigation. We met with Mr. Jesse Ogden, President of the Holiday Shores Home Owners Assoc and Ms. Alma OByan, Treasurer of the Holiday Shores Home Owners Assoc. We observed the area where the Holiday Shores subdivision has dumpsters and the area where burning had occurred. Mr. Rick Pretz informed them that the residential solid waste could not be collected at a central location and burned. There was a small pile of vegetative material at the site. I discussed the need for a burn permit when the vegetative waste is collected at a central site.</p> <p>Rick Pretz followed up with a notice of violation (NOV) and stated the following: All solid wastes and ashes from previous burning of wastes must be properly disposed of at a permitted transfer station or landfill. No burning of regulated wastes is allowed. Future burning of yard wastes will require a "Burning Permit" issued by the Southeast Regional Office Air Unit. The collection of solid wastes must meet the Solid Waste Management Law and regulations for collection, transportation, storage and disposal.</p> <p>Required Action: By August 25, 2016, all wastes must be cleaned up and hauled to a permitted transfer station or landfill; or you can contract with a trash service to provide a dumpster for the wastes to be hauled to a permitted facility. By August 30, 2016, this office must receive verification of proper disposal in the form of receipts given to you by the facility that was used to dispose of the waste.</p> <p>NOV issued by Rick Pretz, SERO, SWMP</p>
