Mr. Mike Zoellner showed me photographs of the structure, which had formerly belonged to MFA Oil Company and was used as a warehouse. Mr. Zoellner said that the building was mostly wood construction with tin on the roof and on the sides of the building. Mr. Zoellner stated that Birk Trucking had demolished the building. Mr. Zoellner said that a demolition permit had been obtained from the City of Jackson (City of Jackson Permit: 2945); but the City of Jackson had said nothing about the asbestos regulatory requirements. On June 26, 2015, I spoke by telephone to Mr. Dewayne Birk, Owner of Birk Trucking, Inc. Mr. Birk stated that he had applied for and received a demolition permit from the City of Jackson; but that the City of Jackson had not said anything about getting a building inspection or making notification to the state prior to the demolition project. Mr. Birk stated that he thought the rules probably would not apply, since it did not appear that there were any asbestos-containing building materials in the building. The off-specification material, which includes calcined petroleum coke and non-usable carbon anodes, is stored outside awaiting recycle back into the production of new anodes. It is anticipated the stored material will be recycled over an extended period of time. Both alumina and calcined petroleum coke are used in dry scrubbers at Noranda Aluminum. Alumina is used to capture particulates and total fluorides from the pot lines and the carbon anode bake furnaces. Calcined petroleum coke is used at the paste production plant to scrub emissions from the coal tar pitch, which is a component of the paste used as a binder for the carbon anodes. The carbon anodes are manufactured from a mixture of calcined petroleum coke, recycled carbon anode material, and coal tar pitch. These materials form the paste that is formed into carbon anodes for use in the electrolytic reduction pots where aluminum is produced. It is unlikely that reacted ore would be reused in scrubbers because it would be ineffective in capturing fluorides, which are especially necessary to maintain the electrolytic reduction chemistry in the pots. When fluoride is released it has to be added back to the pots to maintain correct chemistry; this may be achieved by the addition of cryolite and aluminum fluoride; but both of these must be purchased. It is much less expensive to recycle fluorides by capturing them in the dry scrubbers' alumina and introducing the fluorides along with the reacted alumina ore into the electrolytic reduction pots for use in the aluminum metal production process.  No violations were noted.
