Two weeks ago the baghouse malfunctioned and allowed the emissions to escape confinement and enter the ambient air. If the magnahelic gauge was being read as required the malfunction would have been found quickly and prevented some of the emission from entering the ambient air.

The railroad has piled hundreds and perhaps thousands of creosote soaked railroad ties on both sides of the rail line in this area. They are particularly concerning as they are new and very strong with creosote. When it rains the terrain naturally runs off toward the river. I am certain carcinogenic chemicals are leaching into the warm Fork River. Additionally, there is myself and family who live at 302 Front. A family with about 5 children who live just across the street from one of the piles of ties, the ambulance station and several small apartments across the street from the location. So I am concerned it is not healthy for the river or the people. The air is so thick with the smell of creosote that it burns your eyes when you are outside, and can almost take your breath away if you get a good blast of air from that direction.

The sight of most concern is the downtown Thayer area from the police station to a cover lumber, which is about 1/2 mile area. Just between that area and Highway 63 is warm Fork River, which is of great concern.

Comments On May 27, 2015, Investigator visited the husband of the concerned party at their place of business, Relic Architecture. A bit of the creosote smell was in the air at the time of investigation. There was one railcar stacked full of ties on the tracks (see photo), another two stacks of ties were on the ground across the tracks (see photo). There was a large stacked pile north of these along the tracks across from the Thayer Plant Food Building (see photo) and a pile of ties on the south side of the concerned party's building. Mr. Toomey stated that the pile next to his business had been there for a couple months now and have never been left around this long in the past. The ones across the tracks have been there approximately four months or so.

On June 1, 2015, Investigator spoke via telephone with Mr. Gene See, the office manager/supervisor of the BNSF Thayer South Subdivision located at 126 Front Street. Mr. See was informed of the concern and stated that the older RR ties are to be loaded within thirty days. The two main RR lines will soon be having the ties replaced in the Thayer yard area in both directions. Therefore, the ties will not be in the area for much longer.

No further investigation required by this investigator on this concern at this time.

Comments Observed a blast at Strack Excavating DBA Strack Stone in Fruitland on Wednesday 5-26-2015. Stack Stone uses a blasting company to complete the work. The blast at the quarry was monitored and reported to MSHA by the blasting company. The numbers on the northern property line (closest to the complainants home) was 106 decibels and .153 on the seismograph. Both numbers are below the limits established by MSHA. According to the information received from the blasting company the MSHA limits are as follows less than 133 decibels and 1.25 Thousands of an inch of movement at the property line.

During the investigation I did not observe dust leaving the property. Strack Stone is only blasting and moving rock to storage piles. Strack Stone has not started crushing stone, they are projecting to start moving in equipment next week. This equipment will include a water truck for the fugitive emissions. Another company was using Strack property as a staging area for their equipment and they had a water truck on site.

Steam is generated from the water in the logs during the drying process. Flickerwood Farms has a construction permit that limits the facilities pollution to 15 tons per year of particulate matter and 20% opacity from the stack.</p> <p>The 12 month rolling total for April was 7.8 tons. The opacity was less than 10%.</p> <p>Mr. Boardman is aware some particulates from the stack are causing a problem for the neighbors even though he is not in violation of his permit. He is researching potential solutions to help alleviate some of the issues. These possible solutions include changing the stack on the cyclone to push the particulates in another direction. Planting trees and shrubs along the property boundary. Allowing the logs to lay and dry longer to remove some of the moisture. Closer monitoring of the dryer speeds on days when there is a temperature inversion, windy conditions, excessive moisture etc.</p> <p>No violation observed. Continue to work with Mr. Boardman and Flickerwood Farms to address some of these issues.</p>
