CP states that 3 or 4 years ago the house was victim to a house fire, and recently the home was knocked down. On his way home from work on 9/22, he noticed thick black smoke. He drove by the smoke because it was near his corn field, and noticed the demolished house was on fire, and unattended. There was a gas can near by. CP called the Corder FD and they were able to put most of the fire out in two trips, and they should have a report. He does not remember who he spoke with at the FD.</p> <p>CP would like DNR to speak with the City Hall and inform them of the burning regulation because he believes that the city does not care, and probably allowed this to happen.</p> <p>CP is worried about the health of the people around the home, and states that some neighbors were scared that their homes would burn from the heat. CP states that the postmaster lives across the street from the demolished home, and she would be willing to cooperate if needed. CP is a farmer, so is not always with his telephone, but will return a message. Owner information was obtained through GIS.</p> <p><b>Comments</b> A letter of warning will be issued to the property owner of where the burn occurred. Also there will be mailed to City all fact sheets and the open burn regulation so that they are aware of the regulation.</p>

We have been smelling fumes (paint fumes) for several months. Several times we have had to shut our windows because the fumes were so strong and they were coming into our home. The wind was coming from the south in the direction of the Ford Plant.</p> <p>On November 2nd, my wife and I returned home at approximately 4:30 pm. I pulled into my driveway and when we got out of the vehicle, the fumes were extremely strong. Since we have been smelling the fumes, we have experienced sinus problems, headaches and burning eyes. I had to go to the doctor twice the last month suffering from sinusitis.</p> <p>On November 3rd at around 4:15 pm, I smelled the fumes and got into my vehicle and drove down 69 Hwy toward the Ford Plant. The wind was coming from the south and when I reached the front of the Ford Plant, the fumes were really strong.</p> <p>The fumes usually start around 4:00 pm and into the evening after sunset."</p> <p>CP would like to remain anonymous, but is willing to speak with inspectors if need be. The burial site is on the west side of the structure.</p> <p>There are some political issues surrounding this problem for me, such as his wife is a city Alderperson. The complainant/witness is the neighbor and another, but not a fan of Alderperson Dow, alderperson for the city as well. It's an interesting struggle that I really would have preferred to have stayed out of, but with one it would be failure to act and with the other who already doesn't like me, it's a whatever I guess.</p> <p>Get with me before going there please. Would like if at all possible to keep things anonymous if possible. I will however tell you that I have had to get onto Tommy Dow, owner, about illegal burning of shingles and plastic siding there before. In the last 60 days he tried to burn the shingles he presumably buried. I told him that day I'd write him a citation if they burned the shingles. The fire he had at the time was wood parts. He let it burn down then put it out with a city fire truck.</p> <p>The area that the business is located in is a well known TARKIO Creek flood plain area. It tried to flood that area out this summer I don't know how many times. Really pisses me off. I'm a hunter and all and I do my part to always preserve wildlife and there habitat. This is just willful and wanton greed. I know for with a hi degree of certainty that he was paid for proper disposal of the shingles and this is what he did to make a lil extra money.</p> <p>Get with me when you can, my number is 660-953-1648. If I don't pick up, leave a message and I'll call you back.</p>					
<b>Comments</b>	<p>I went to the site on 12/4 and took pictures from the road. I found Mr. Dow's truck at another location, but his workers said he just left so I left my card for him. On 12/8 I spoke to Mr. Dow and he said he was disposing of the shingles properly and would send me receipts. I told him it looked like something was buried and he said that he was burning wood siding from his business an buried the ashes. I informed Mr. Dow that even if the wood was untreated, it was considered trade waste and he could not burn it.</p> <p>Mr. Dow is sending receipts for the shingles. I wrote a letter to him explaining regulations, along with some fact sheets, and asked him to clean the ashes up and dispose of them properly and send in receipts.</p>

Of course the answer to this question is the economic impact the company has on the people in the area, they don't like what goes on but as with anyone they need a place to work. For many years we have watched this cycle in the Viburnum area but living on the side of Viburnum away from the mines I never have felt like it was my problem. That has changed over the last year or so. The day of November the second 2015 has completely went to far and November three and four have also had periods of being horrible. The strong sulfuric smell which can only come from one place the doe run smelter. The smell was so bad in Dillard that I put my shirt over my nose trying to block out some of the smell this sadly has happened several times in the past but never this severe. The smell seems to be much worse on the ridge tops than in the bottoms. I feel like I live far enough from doe run and there pollution I should not have to have this happen. If a person can not live in the mark twain national forest next to the Dillard mill state historic site and breath clean air then where can we. This has gone on far to long and I apologize for not reporting this sooner. I do understand the economics of the situation for the town of viburnum but living 6 miles from the town in Crawford county I don't think my air and my family's home for 150 years should be sacrificed. Please do not right this off as just someone who hates mining or hates the doe run company or has nothing better to do than complain that is not me at all. I understand the importance of mining and think the recycling of batteries is a great practice but it has to be done in a manner better than what is happening now. The MSDS indicated that the product was "Super Seal 25 NY VT" manufactured by Clemons Concrete Coatings of Tennessee. The product contains an acrylic polymer and various aromatic solvents including primarily naphtha (12%) and trace amounts of Naphthalene and benzene. VOC content is <350 g/l and solids content is 25%. It is advertised as a low-VOC and slow drying product. The odor of the solvents and the slow dry at the temperatures on November 4 & 5, 20014 (mid-40's through low 60's °F) may have caused the odor to linger longer, and the light and variable wind (mostly westerly) could have directed the solvent odor toward the complainant's residence.
