There is a sign on the side of the truck that says Vic's Hillbilly Trash Service. CP is with the fire department and received a call a couple months ago about a fire at the site. When he investigated he saw that it was a controlled burn, but didn't know the full situation. The CP also lives next door to the site.</p> <p>The property is owned by the owners of A-1 storage on the same site. CP thinks the parents own the property and storage facility, but their son is running the trash business. The trucks come and go from the property all day long bringing in trash. The burn site is about 100 yards down the drive way. You probably can't see it from Highway 83 because of a drop off.</p> <p>RP had originally ordered a roll off from Ozark Disposal. RP would burn the trash and the stuff that wouldn't burn was placed in the roll off. When Ozark Disposal found out what the RP was doing, they removed the roll off. CP is not sure what is happening to the unburned waste now.</p>

Asphalt are required to submit information reported in Form R as their names did not appear in a search done in Missouri facility chemical-releasers in the TRI (Toxic Release Inventory). There was no additional information found in MOEIS (Missouri Emission Inventory System) identifying specific hazardous air pollutants being released or emitted by C. B. Asphalt. It is true that the above two chemical compounds among others are released by Noranda Aluminum and are being reported by Noranda Aluminum on Form R; but it does not seem that Noranda Aluminum is committing a state or federal violation simply because of their routine release of these two chemicals. However, Noranda Aluminum is subject to state and federal air and hazardous waste regulations and is routinely inspected by state and federal inspectors. Chester Bross Construction and C. B.
