The fire department initially responded to a 200-acre grass fire at the site yesterday, 4/1/2015. The fire department has been back to the site two times today (4/2/2015) because the pit is still on fire and still causing reduced visibility on 2 Highway. The fire department is having a hard time controlling the fire in the pit because the ground is shifting and dirt is falling on top. The pit is located on the south side of the field. The chief estimates the pit is about 6 to 8 18-wheelers in length, 10 feet deep, and 10 feet wide. The pit contains tires, clothes, construction materials, possibly from tearing down a house, appliances, carpet, etc.					
Comments	There is no houses or buildings on the property belonging to the landowner, but there are houses on other properties about 2 football fields from the pit/fire. You cannot see the pit from the street, but you can see smoke. The Chief did not have an address or the landowners contact information at the time of the telephone call. They don't have sawdust or particulate catchers on the saws. The saws throw dust and particulate into the air and all around the surrounding area. All the homes in the area use well water as a source of drinking water, and this mill is within 50 feet of the water way that provides most of our families with water. I also question their storm water runoff plan, many times after the rain the stream and connecting ponds have an oily sheen to them, along with all the debris that washes into the water. Several times we have seen dead fish floating in the pond just south of the facility. This stream runs into the Missouri River approximately 3 miles from this point. I also do worry about their human waste disposal, being so close to the water way at the business listed and their home sits directly near the working location and on the edge of the pond near a drinking water well. There is a oil dumped on the ground and around the buildings. There is a sheen on the water nearly all the time. There may even be a tank buried that they dump used oil into. The saws and the motors that run the saws do not have mufflers or any kind of noise limiting devices. They also burn large amounts of materials, trash, pallets, lumber, plastic chemical and oil containers. This mill is located very close to my home and I have a great concern for the health and safety of my children and our neighbors. Hopefully someone can look into this and help this business be within all regulatory guidelines.

During times of temperature inversions and high humidity smoke emitted from the stack can stay closer to the ground and appear to be more than usual. Also, during the startup or shutdown of equipment the opacity is allowed to exceed 20% opacity for a specified period of time.

This facility only uses pine sawdust in the burner, however they are allowed to use any sawdust they choose. The equipment manufacturer requires the dust is dry. There is a large amount of steam from this process. The equipment is set up so all the steam from the process of drying the wood go through the cyclone with the emissions. This can appear to look like smoke to the untrained eye.

I called and left a message for Chief Borders at this number on Monday April 13, 2015. April 20, 2015, I called and spoke with Chief Borders. He said that he will send me a report after May 1, 2015.

On April 20, 2015, I called Wayne Ivy, the person that ran the business and Lindel Ward, the property owner. Both denied setting the tires on fire and felt that it was the other person's responsibility to clean up the site. Mr. Ward gave me permission to enter the site.

I went to the site and no one was there on April 23, 2015. I saw where 150-200 of scrap tires had burned. Nearby was a pile of rubbish that had mostly burned. There were about 200 scrap tires still remaining on site.

May 4, 2015, I spoke briefly with Mr. Ivy who is not feeling well. He had me speak with Linda Sargent, who is his caregiver and said she has power of attorney. She said she will be cleaning up the property as quickly as she can considering that she has no money. I advised her that they cannot open burn any of the wastes from the building since it is business trade waste. She said she knew that and would abide by the regulations.

I forwarded this information and copies of the photos to Amy Baker for her consideration concerning air pollution issues.

They are located just outside the city limits. The City of Nevada has agreed to accept wastewater from the facility. I told him that if the city agreed to take their wastewater, a pretreatment agreement should be in place, even if the facility was outside the city limits. Mr. Middendorf said they would work with the company to solve the problem. Mr. Richard Barnes with the Southwest Regional Office also investigated this concern in regard to the Air Pollution Control Program. He stated Nutra Flow was working to resolve the issue regarding odor in their service line. There were no water quality problems or violations of the Missouri Clean Water Law regarding this specific concern.

There are dozens of areas that the Trail riders travel across this stream, although the Managers will say they only cross in designated areas. Most of the structures in this "Coast to Coast Resort" are falling apart and several buildings are being partially renovated, which concerns many of us because these folks refuse to accept the fact that there is some dangerous health concerns there. All the Pool Tables and furniture that was in the contaminated buildings were relocated without any proper cleaning to the Restaurant and childrens play areas.
