On 9/16/14, the dust their equipment tracked onto the road was so thick there was a cloud stirred up higher than the cars driving through it. This happens constantly and has been going on for years but seems to be particularly bad this year. When they do use their watering system, they track thick grey sludge onto the road instead. I believe this material is caustic. There is also gravel tracked onto the roads. Earlier this year a strong north wind blew great clouds of dust across the road and through neighborhoods to the south. This road is heavily trafficked and is a main thorough fare for our neighborhood.					
<b>Comments</b>	I verbally advised Mr. Scott to get the wheel washing system fixed as soon as possible, as that should help cut down dust. If there are further issues with the facility we will issue a letter of warning or, if needed, a notice of excess emissions.

As I was discussing the situation with him he sounded uncomfortable and asked for someone in the department more relative to his issue. I handed the telephone over to Andrea Collier, the Regional Director, as no one was currently available in the air program at KCRO. Steve stated to Director Collier that the company was daily drilling 15 holes 400' deep for residential construction of geothermal heating and cooling system. He alleged that it is extremely dusty and one can see dust on his red tile roof. The issue is located across the street from the concern party's (CP) house on the 1200 block of West 56th Street (south side of 56th Street). Mr. Catron stated he would like follow up on this issue as the activity (drilling) will be taking place all week. Provided the KCMO Air Quality Department telephone number <(816) 513-6314> to Mr. Catron for him to assure they check the work performed by the geothermal company.					
<b>Comments</b>	Concern involves fugitive dust within the city limits of Kansas City, Missouri; therefore, the concern was forwarded to the local air pollution agency. Ms. Catherine Reid of the KCMO Air Quality Department cited the drilling company on 9/29/14, for a violation of Kansas City's code. Ms. Reid may go back over the morning of 9/30/14, to check out the site. Referred to local agency.

Moberly Mobile Home Park was owned by Bayview Loan Servicing, L.L.C., Vendor Resource Management, with onsite management conducted by Derik King.

On June 13, 2014, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources' Northeast Regional Office (NERO) received two reports regarding a dumpster fire at 4760 Highway JJ, in Huntsville, Randolph County, Missouri.

The NERO investigated the concern on June 10, 18, 23, and 25, 2014. During the investigation, the NERO documented that the utilities were paid monthly by the residents to the onsite manager, however, the management company failed to pay the utilities, including trash services, which resulted in a large accumulation of trash on site on June 10, 2014. Two small dumpsters on site were filled and waste overflowed onto the ground. Unknown persons eventually set the dumpsters of trash on fire on June 12, 2014, in an effort to address the rotting trash on site.

The NERO called Bayview Loan Servicing, L.L.C. to discuss trash and sewer issues, which resulted in being redirected to Vendor Resource Management, as they were in charge of handling the bill payments for the property. The NERO then contacted Vendor Resource Management on June 19, 2014, and were told that they had been given approval that day for an expedited payment to Advanced Disposal for payment of the trash bill.

On June 27, 2014, Advanced Disposal picked up the trash at the Mobile Home Park in anticipation of getting a payment from Vendor Resource Management. Payment for the outstanding balance was made on July 2, 2014.

In response to the investigation, the NERO issued Notice of Violation #NER2014062614175142 to Bayview Loan Servicing, L.L.C., for the violation of Missouri Air Conservation Commission Regulations, 10 CSR 10-6.045 “*Open Burning Regulations.*”

The Water Protection Program and Solid Waste Management Program have referred violations at this site to the Attorney General’s Office to facilitate a multi-media resolution.

On August 26, 2014, the Air Pollution Control Program sent Bayview Asset Management notification of this proposed referral, giving them the opportunity to speak at the Missouri Air Conservation Commission meeting regarding the issues. No response was received other than notification that Bayview Loan Servicing had sold the property on July 31, 2014.

Therefore, the Air Program has requested the Director of the Missouri Department of Natural Resources to request the Attorney General’s Office to institute a civil action in a court of competent jurisdiction on behalf of the Missouri Air Conservation Commission and Missouri Department of Natural Resources.

Mr. Stephen Craig Strong lives at 18062 Private Drive 3482, in St. Joseph, Andrew County, Missouri. Mr. Strong owned and operated Budget Concrete Construction, Inc. and Central Disposal Service, Inc., both of which were administratively dissolved by the Missouri Secretary of State on March 5, 2014, for failure to file a correct and current annual report. Mr. Strong has a Solid Waste Management Law violation, which has been referred to the Attorney General's Office.

On June 17, 2014, the Department's Kansas City Regional Office (KCRO) received an environmental concern reporting that Mr. Strong was burning waste from his waste hauling business about once a week.

On June 18, 2014, a representative from the KCRO investigated the concern. During the investigation, Mr. Strong admitted to open burning concrete forms from his business, Budget Concrete Construction, Inc., and renovation waste from his shop. Notice of Violation (NOV) #KCR20140630 10273762 was issued to Mr. Strong to document the violation of Missouri Air Conservation Regulation 10 CSR 10-6.045, "*Open Burning Requirements.*"

On July 29, 2014, the NOV was mailed to Mr. Strong via certified mail.

On August 27, 2014, the Air Pollution Control Program made the decision to refer this enforcement matter to the Attorney General's Office to be combined with the ongoing Solid Waste Violations.

Minimal conference, conciliation and persuasion have been performed by the Air Pollution Control Program, due to combining the Missouri Air Conservation Regulation violation with the Missouri Solid Waste Management violations, which have been referred to the Attorney General's Office for resolution.

On October 2, 2014, the Air Pollution Control Program sent Mr. Strong notification of this proposed referral. No response was received.

Therefore, the Air Pollution Control Program is requesting the Attorney General's Office to institute a civil action in a court of competent jurisdiction on behalf of the Missouri Air Conservation Commission and Missouri Department of Natural Resources.
