Perry Agricultural Laboratory (PAL), Inc., is one of five businesses operated at 15241 Pike 138 in Bowling Green, Missouri. PAL provides a range of agricultural analytical services for soil, water, plant tissues, seed and grain, as well as manure and fertilizer analysis.

On May 21, 2014, staff from the Missouri Department of Natural Resources Northeast Regional Office (NERO) performed an investigation into concerns with the waste management practices at PAL. A compliance evaluation inspection of the facility's hazardous waste management practices was performed in conjunction with the investigation.

As a result of the investigation, on June 6, 2014, the NERO issued a Letter of Warning (LOW) #14.NE004 for violations of the Missouri Hazardous Waste Management Law. The letter also identified other compliance concerns regarding Air Pollution, Solid Waste and Water Pollution regulations relating to the facility's waste management practices. The LOW required a written response to be provided to NERO by August 15, 2014. The written response was to specifically respond to hazardous waste issues documented during the investigation. Additionally, the response was to address the other environmental compliance concerns identified in the Inspection and Investigation Report. Specific to the Missouri Air Conservation Law, the NERO requested information relating to asbestos compliance during past/future renovations of the structure and open burning compliance relating to the proper disposal of trade wastes.

On August 12, 2014, PAL requested additional time to evaluate all of the issues identified during the investigation. The NERO granted an extension of the response date to September 8, 2014.

On September 10, 2014, the NERO received PAL's written response dated September 8, 2014. The response letter addressed several of PAL's concerns regarding the manner of the investigation, however did not provide the information and corrective actions as requested in the LOW.

Therefore, on October 10, 2014, the NERO issued three Notices of Violation (NOV) to PAL to document the various violations of the Missouri Air Conservation Law, Clean Water Law and Hazardous Waste Management Law.

Specific to the Missouri Air Conservation Law, the NERO issued NOV #NER2014100813565016 for the following air pollution violations:

- Failure to thoroughly inspect for asbestos prior to conducting renovation activities of a regulated structure in violation of 10 CSR 10-6.080, "*Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants*," which adopts by reference 40 CFR Part 61, Subpart M, "*National Emission Standard for Asbestos*."
- Open burning of trade wastes in violation of 10 CSR 10-6.045, "*Open Burning Requirements*."

On April 17, 2015, the department's Water Protection and Hazardous Waste Programs referred violations at PAL to the Attorney General's Office to assist with resolution of the multi-media issues at the site.

Therefore, the Air Program has requested the Director of the Missouri Department of Natural Resources to request the Attorney General's Office to institute a civil action in a court of competent jurisdiction on behalf of the Missouri Air Conservation Commission and Missouri Department of Natural Resources.

SUBJECT: Department Director's Referral to the Attorney General's Office– Renewable Environmental Solutions, LLC/Ridgeline Energy Services

Renewable Environmental Solutions, LLC (RES) is a biodiesel production facility that previously used turkey production offal primarily sourced from Butterball, LLC to produce a renewable diesel fuel at their facility located at 530 North Main Street, Carthage, Jasper County. In past years, the Air Pollution Control Program worked closely with the facility and the Attorney General's Office to address noncompliance issues, namely odor violations, at the site.

In recent years, in order to reduce odors and improve production, the company switched to a brown grease waste shipped in from out of state. The department has not substantiated odor violations since this waste switch.

On May 12, 2015, Butterball LLC, the owners of the property where RES is located, contacted the department indicating a possible leaking tank of sulfuric acid at the RES facility.

On May 13 and June 2, 2015, staff from the department's Environmental Emergency Response (EER) and Southwest Regional Office (SWRO) conducted assessments and inspections of the site. SWRO documented violations of the Hazardous Waste Management Law and the Clean Water Law.

In addition, from a data review, it was determined that RES failed to submit their Emissions Inventory Questionnaire (EIQ) for calendar year 2014 and had submitted the 2013 EIQ late. Air Program staff contacted RES in May 2015, and provided a copy of the requisite form, but as of this date, it has not been submitted.

Therefore, on June 9, 2015, the SWRO issued Notices of Violation (NOV) to RES to document the various violations of the Missouri Air Conservation Law, Clean Water Law and Hazardous Waste Management Law.

Specific to the Missouri Air Conservation Law, the SWRO issued NOV #16309SW for failure to submit the 2014 EIQ in violation of 10 CSR 10-6.110, "*Reporting Emission Data, Emission Fees and Process Information.*"

On June 26, 2015, the department's Water Protection and Hazardous Waste Programs referred violations at RES to the Attorney General's Office to assist with resolution of the multi-media issues at the site.

Therefore, the Air Program has requested the Director of the Missouri Department of Natural Resources to request the Attorney General's Office to institute a civil action in a court of competent jurisdiction on behalf of the Missouri Air Conservation Commission and Missouri Department of Natural Resources.
