

Dear Mr. Fink:

This letter is an addendum to your approval 98-02 dated October 9, 1998. This addendum letter shall serve as your MOPETP approval for the modification to your Husky Stage II Balance Vapor Recovery Nozzles # 5010 V and 5210 V.

Husky Corporation submitted to the Technical Review Committee (TRC), November 20, 2001, a modification to the interface between the bellows and the collar on the bellows assembly. This modification consisted of adding small studs to the bellows collar, which lock into small dimples in the bellows. This creates a non-slip condition between these two components. This modification was in response to concerns the TRC observed with the bellows sometimes slipping around and losing orientation with the nozzle, thereby causing it to fail to make a proper seal. Husky quickly engineered a cure for this possible reduction in capture efficiency.

All new Husky Stage II Vapor Recovery Nozzles # 5010 V Short or # 5210 V Long shall be equipped with this non-slip lock feature. Existing nozzles will be allowed to remain for two (2) years following this approval as long as these existing nozzles do not exhibit the slipping / disorientation problem. Inspectors observing nozzles with these disorientation problems will require the bellows be replaced with the new bellows assembly.
