	<b>Concern No.</b> 40804	<b>Concern Info</b>	SP:23514 A demolition in progress at the corner of Merrimac and Springfield, in St. James, Missouri, Phelps County. Mr. Ron Morela called with an environmental concern, and noted that he knew there had been asbestos piping in the building in the past.					
	<b>Comments</b>	On October 31, 2019, I went by this demolition of concern. Most of the building is down and they are hauling everything to the transfer station between Rolla and St. James. I spoke with the contractor, Mr. Justin Sherfy with Reliable Excavating and he didn't seem to know anything about asbestos or a inspection being done prior to demo. He did state that he went to the city prior to demolition activities and was granted permission to begin demolition. He mentioned the building was dilapidated and partially inaccessible. I mentioned to Mr. Sherfy that in the case of an unsafe structure that a wet demolition should be performed where everything is disposed of as asbestos containing material. Although, from the looks of the demo, there was no brick, steel, wood and concrete on the ground. It looked like mostly clean fill material. It could be considered a wet demo as it rained the past couple days and there was little dust on site and no dust leaving the property. When I mentioned asbestos piping, he did say that it looked like things had been stripped prior sometime or years before because there was nothing on any pipes. He stated there wasn't much of anything in the building, as it has been vacant and dilapidated for years. See the attached photos.

She said they are drilling it, and breaking it up, and as they remove the shingles they are not being careful about where they go. She has found the material all over her yard and driveway and is concerned about potential asbestos exposure. She is also concerned about the workers because they aren't wearing any type of protection while doing this work.					
			CP said the house was recently bought and is being completely gutted and redone. She believes they may be flipping the house, but is not sure. She said she knows there is asbestos because they were looking at the house when it was up for sale and were notified of it by the appraiser.

I work in a plant that's directly in the line of fire when the wind from the south. We have people becoming ill and it's worsening. It's being released on a daily basis and it's making it hard to breathe, producing vomiting, nausea, disorientation, and other health issues. It's also near a residential area with children."</p> <p>Adrienne Ciolli with EPA conducted an initial investigation. She provided the following: " I spoke to Lauren Caudle and Arnc Tejada at Johnson Controls, who confirmed the odor complaints. I then spoke to Doug Cerra and Jerry Hawkins at RitePak. They were making their mosquito repellent and snake repellent when Johnson Controls first experienced the fumes/odors, which made two employees sick. Doug Cerra provided the air permit to me, and he indicated they are still testing their ventilation system. 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<b>Concern No.</b> 40960	<b>Concern Info</b>	<p>CP said that 5 apartment complex buildings near the big cathedral in St. Joseph had been demolished with no Demolition Notification and no inspections performed. The buildings demolished had addresses of 607, 611, 613, 615, and 617 N. 10th St. The CP believed the cathedral owned these properties. The CP said that the debris was hauled off to a ditch in the country. CP is willing to show us the location of the debris if needed.</p> <p>The CP said the contractor may now be demolishing a building at 909 Robidoux St., also with inspections or notifications.</p>

They are not sampling from the permitted outfall. They are sampling from a different location by the office in order to have better effluent.</p> <p>They are collecting wash out in Area 2 on the southside of the plant in 55-100 gallon containers. When it rains they open the containers so it will overflow the containers. As it overflows it enters the ditch and is then conveyed through stormwater sewers to the Little Blue. They also have containers of chemical product sitting out opened and exposed to stormwater. Based on the multiple allegations, it sounds like there are potentially various permit violations.</p> <p>He has observed a white film on the Little Blue which he believes is a result of discharge coming from Barbour Concrete</p> <p>He has not contacted the City of Independence about this yet.</p> <p>They also have dust issues. They used water, but they don't anymore. When they did apply water it was process water from the concrete basins (at 23rd) connected to the batch plant. The dust is carried for miles around the area.</p> <p>CP is a former employee 6 months ago. He stressed multiple times that if we give prior notification, the company will work to cover up these issues because he believes they are intentionally working the system.</p>					
<b>Comments</b>			I told them to not set any uncovered barrels in the watershed; get rid of all used barrels; make sure that material does not accumulate in the outfalls; water the yard so that dust does not leave the property; sample all four outfalls quarterly.

Caller reports that six houses have been pushed into piles and open burned in Mineral Point, Missouri on a rainy day (the day before Thanksgiving).

**Comments** The computer system in the Washington County Assessor's Office has been having difficulties. I called several times and did not receive the kind of accurate information that would be helpful for this kind of case. I went to the site and found little evidence of what occurred.

The Town of Mineral Point (less than 400 people) was contacted with information about the regulations in hopes of enlisting their support in policing the town to help prevent this kind of thing in the future if it occurs.

November 26, 2019, I called the concerned party to ask if we could meet at his place of residence, to which he agreed. While waiting to meet with the concerned party, I parked along the concerned party's street and began walking up and down for five to ten minutes McRee Avenue to observe any particles on the ground or surfaces of the street. It is notable to mention that it rained the night before, which would have washed particles off the surfaces. I also walked to the intersection of South Vandeventer Avenue and McRee, and stood at the edge of McRee avenue to observe Re-Poly, the entrance of which is right across the street. The Re-Poly building is located to the right (Northeast) of the facility's main entrance and I observed a large opening into the building at the Northeastern edge of the building. I did not observe any plastic particulate matter leaving the large opening nor did I clearly observe any particulate matter along McRee Avenue.

I then approached the concerned party's house, knocked on the door, introduced myself to the concerned party, and then began asking questions regarding the concern. During our conversation, Mr. Mosley explained that he has been living at his house for approximately ten years and Re-Poly hasn't been at the location for more than a few years. He stated that during hot, sunny, and windy days, plastic particles blow from the Re-Poly proper and directly onto his property, covering the ground, his car, etc.. It has occurred approximately a half dozen times since July of 2019 (which is around the time he submitted a concern to the City of St. Louis). Mr. Mosley showed me photographs, which were stored on his phone, of the phenomenon. The photographs showed part of the side of his black vehicle, where what appeared to be light, artificial/plastic looking particulate matter could be seen significantly covering the surface.

Mr. Mosley then guided me to his backyard, where you could clearly see the large opening from Re-Poly and stacks of pre-processed "recycled" plastic material stacked outside across a parking lot and across the street from the concerned party's residence. The opening appeared to be approximately a few hundred feet in distance from the concerned party's back yard. He believes that the particles are coming from the large opening along the side of building and is concerned about breathing in the particles and the particles affecting the quality of his vegetable garden. I walked around the backyard, but did not observe any particulate matter visible on the surfaces of the concerned party's car/backyard nor did I observe particulate matter leaving the opening or visible in the air between Re-Poly and the concerned party's house and originating from the property.

I then exchanged farewells with Mr. Mosley and then drove over to Re-Poly. At 2:04 pm, I parked at the entrance of Re-Poly and walked towards the entrance of the building. At the time of the arrival, the wind speed was 9 mph, the temperature was 62 degrees Fahrenheit. When walking from the official entrance, I observed a significant amount of gray "fluff" pieces and scraps of brightly colored large particulate matter on the property. I entered the building vestibule, asked to speak with a representative of the business to the employee at the desk, who then contacted Mr. Charlie Charleston. I
