"My concern is plans are being made by my new neighbor to bury hazardous material that could affect ground water.

The material was observed in January 2019. It includes medical supplies, such as five or six recyclable oxygen tanks, observed in a pile with other rubbish and brush when Joey Sexton, son of the deceased prior owner gave me a tour of their old home and grounds. Today, the hired man for Bruce Ray, Manager for John Marshall III, stated they had been approached by Mr. Glastetter, owner of the property with the rubbish, to use their excavator to do some grading. Informed the request was turned down. Also, earlier today I attended the NBC Fire Protection District meeting. At the meeting the Fire Chief Shawna Schmitt stated there had been an inspection of this home to prepare for a Fire Training exercise. First the owner was to remove from the home before the training, the oil base shingles from the roof and the flooring rugs. When inside the house in January I did observe laminate flooring in the kitchen. During the meeting it was not stated there was a requirement how the material was to be disposed. Maybe the inspection report provides how the material is to be disposed. The chief stated the inspection was into DNR, but a report had not been provided.

Can I see a copy of the pre-house-fire-training inspection report? It was stated that a Tim Peko made the inspection. I am further concerned about the potential of asbestos. During my first observation I noticed the outside siding appeared to be the same material that my mother had years ago on a shed. We were informed for her shed the siding was asbestos. Did the inspection of the house for the fire training include sampling of the siding? Is it asbestos? Does the report state how the material is to be disposed?

I believe my concern for damage to ground water quality is valid. I shared a garden for five years with Mrs. Sexton on this property. At that site, below the silt loam at 18 to 24 inches there is a layer of rock, gravel and sand. Furthermore, parts of the property border an intermittent stream with clearly defined bed and banks. The landowner on the south, John Marshall, has dug a drainage ditch down to the rock layer. This ditch will further draw now the hydrology. The field to the south is in a FEMA identified flood zone. Any hazardous material taken from the house and buried jeopardizes three private wells with pollution.

Prior to the site visit, I spoke with the concerned party via phone conversation. I asked questions regarding the duration of the emissions and how consistent they are observed and updated them the initial concern actions. He also provided me with the names of some neighbors, who may have a clear vantage point to observe the facility from their backyard.

March 26, I drove to the neighborhood next to the facility to find a clear vantage point of the facility building. I first tried to contact the concerned party, but instead spoke to their significant other. We discussed the concern, as well as a different concern regarding noise at all hours of the night. I also tried to contact the neighbors, who did not answer, and left a message.

I then parked at the Enclave at Foxborough, an area still in development, which is approximately 700 feet away from, and southeast of, the main building. From there, I attempted to observe the "stacks" from the building through the trees for approximately ten minutes. I observed no emissions, but did not have a clear viewpoint of the stack, as previously mentioned in the first concern.

At approximately 2:00 p.m., I drove to the facility, parked, and was escorted into the main office, where I spoke with Mr. Dave Poole, Mr. Paul Wilkers and Mr. Jonathan Nichols regarding the inspection and concerns. I asked for further information regarding the plasma cutter and we discussed the tensions between the facility and residential areas nearby.

After the discussion, I was informed that they were experiencing issues with the plasma cutter and that it would be another twenty to thirty minutes before they would be using it. After waiting the twenty minutes, I was then informed that it would take longer than initially estimated. Due to this time (it was approximately 3:00 pm by this time), I decided to leave for the day and informed them that I would arrive the next day to observe the plasma cutter operations.

The next day (March 27), I arrived at the facility at approximately 2:00 pm and waited another fifteen to twenty minutes for the plasma cutter to be in operation. I was then escorted for the second time by Mr. Evan Hauer, a representative of the facility, outside and to the western side of the building to observe the stacks from the outside. During the observations, the time was approximately 2:30 and the sky was clear to partly cloudy. We stood facing the stacks for twenty minutes and I conducted a Method 9 observation, which includes taking opacity readings every fifteen seconds for a period of six minutes. During the readings, I observed faint and gray-ish emissions for approximately one minute in duration two to three times, similar to the previous investigation. At the time of the investigation, I observed that the opacity of the emissions did not exceed five percent. Mr. Hauer then escorted me back



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to the front of the facility and I departed.

April 1, 2019 I left a message for the concerned party to inform him that I investigated the concern.

Comments I called Ms. Schaefferkoetter on 3/29/19 and left a voicemail message. I explained that under 10 CSR 10-6.165 Restriction of Emission of Odors, (1) Applicability part (B), agriculture operations are exempt from odor regulations, with the exception of Class IA CAFOs. I explained that an investigator from the water pollution control unit would be visiting to see if they could observe any runoff from the property, and that they may be able to enforce water quality standards. I also recommended talking directly with the property owner, and contacting the county health department. I then printed a copy of 10 CSR 10-6.165 for Mike Monterastelli, who investigated the water concern.

Ms. Schaefferkoetter called me back later that day, after I had left the office for the weekend, and left a voicemail. She told me that she understood the farm was exempt from odor regulations but asked if there was anything we could do about the potentially hazardous levels of ammonia in the air.

I returned her call on 4/1/19 and explained that the farm was not an air pollution source that we could regulate; we could not sample the air for ammonia and had no criteria ambient air pollutant standards that we could enforce. Ms. Schaefferkoetter told me that she had discussed the issue with Mike Monterastelli on Friday and appreciated the quick response and follow-up. We agreed that the water pollution unit would be most likely to be able to enforce regulations and improve her situation, and that she should contact them again after her neighbor sprays the property so that a sample may be collected. I again recommended that she contact her local health department and discuss her concerns with the property owner, and she thanked me for my assistance.
