

MISSOURI AIR CONSERVATION COMMISSION
WILL HOLD PUBLIC HEARING

JEFFERSON CITY, MO -- The Missouri Air Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, January 31, 2017 beginning at 9 a.m. at the Elm Street Conference Center, 1730 East Elm Street, Lower Level, Bennett Springs Conference Room, Jefferson City, Missouri. The commission will hear testimony related to the following proposed action(s):

* 10 CSR 10-6.070 (amendment) New Source Performance Regulations

This proposed amendment will adopt new emission standards, updates, and clarifications to existing federal rule 40 CFR 60 that were promulgated from January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2015. This rule as a whole establishes acceptable design and performance criteria for specified new or modified emission sources.

* 10 CSR 10-6.075 (amendment) Maximum Achievable Control Technology Regulations

This proposed amendment will adopt new emission standards, updates, and clarifications to existing federal rule 40 CFR 63 that were promulgated from January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2015. This rule as a whole establishes emission control technology, performance criteria, and work practices to achieve emission standards for sources that emit, or have the potential to emit, hazardous air pollutants.

* 10 CSR 10-6.080 (amendment) Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants

This proposed amendment will adopt updates and clarifications to existing federal rule 40 CFR 61 that were promulgated from January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2015. This rule as a whole establishes emission standards and performance criteria for new or modified sources emitting hazardous air pollutants.

The above rule actions will not be submitted for inclusion in the Missouri State Implementation Plan but will be submitted to accept delegation of enforcement authority for federal regulations from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

This information will be available at least 30 days prior to the public hearing date.

The department will accept comments for the record until 5 p.m. on February 7, 2017.
