RE: New Source Review Permit Correction - Permit Number: 022017-010A  
Project Number: 2017-03-014; Installation Number: 510-1390

Dear Mr. Wilson:

After reviewing Permit Number 022017-010, a correction is needed in the Review Summary. The Review Summary of permit 022017-010 incorrectly stated the installation is located in City of St. Louis County, an attainment area for all criteria pollutants. The permit should have stated the installation is located in the City of St. Louis, a nonattainment area for the 1997 and 2008 8-hour ozone standard and for the 1997 PM<sub>2.5</sub> standard and an attainment area for all other criteria pollutants. The installation is not on the List of Named Installations found in 10 CSR 10-6.020(3)(B), Table 2. Due to its nonattainment status, the major source level for PM<sub>2.5</sub>, VOC, and NO<sub>x</sub> is 100 tons per year. The installation's major source level is 250 tons per year for other regulated NSR pollutants. Fugitive emissions are not counted toward major source applicability.

In addition to the above correction, permit 022017-010 stated a general requirement of the ABCO boiler was 10 CSR 10-6.220 Restriction of Emission of Visible Air Contaminants. Per 10 CSR 10-6.220(1)(H) emissions sources regulated by 10 CSR 10-6.070 are exempt from 10 CSR 10-6.220 Restriction of Emission of Visible Air Contaminants. Since the ABCO boiler modification is regulated by 10 CSR 10-6.070, it is exempt from 10 CSR 10-6.220.

The attached special conditions replace the special conditions of permit 022017-017. The updated special conditions supersede all previous special conditions related to the ABCO boiler (referred to as Aboco boiler in permit 02-11-022).

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS:**

The permittee is authorized to construct and operate subject to the following special conditions:

*The special conditions listed in this permit were included based on the authority granted the Missouri Air Pollution Control Program by the Missouri Air Conservation Law (specifically 643.075) and by the Missouri Rules listed in Title 10, Division 10 of the Code of State Regulations (specifically 10 CSR 10-6.060). 1. Superseding Condition

A. The conditions of this permit supersede the following special conditions, limitations, and recordkeeping requirements found in the associated construction permits previously issued by the Air Pollution Control Program.

- 1) Construction Permit 02-10-022
  - a) Section II: Limitations B. ABCO Boiler Specific
  - b) Section IV: Recordkeeping B. ABCO Boiler Specific
- 2) All Special Conditions in Permit 022017-010

2. Fuel Requirement-Boiler

A. American River Transportation Co., LLC shall burn exclusively fuel oil for the boiler (EU-6) with a sulfur content less than or equal to 0.5 % by weight.

B. American River Transportation Co., LLC shall demonstrate compliance with Special Condition 1.A by obtaining records of the fuel's sulfur content from the vendor for each shipment of fuel received or by testing each shipment of fuel for the sulfur content in accordance with the method described in 10 CSR 10-6.040 Reference Methods.

C. American River Transportation Co., LLC shall keep the records required by Special Condition 1.B with the unit and make them available for Department of Natural Resources' employees upon request.

3. Record Keeping and Reporting Requirements

A. American River Transportation Co., LLC shall maintain all records required by this permit for not less than five years and shall make them available immediately to any Missouri Department of Natural Resources' personnel upon request.

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS:**

The permittee is authorized to construct and operate subject to the following special conditions:

- B. American River Transportation Co., LLC shall report to the Air Pollution Control Program's Compliance/Enforcement Section, P.O. Box 176, Jefferson City, MO 65102, no later than 10 days after the end of the month during which any record required by this permit shows an exceedance of a limitation imposed by this permit.
