Dear Mr. Janet:

A mistake was found in Special Condition 4 of construction permit 062017-002. The special condition was worded in a way that limits Delta Asphalt, Inc. to only use diesel fuel in their drum dryer (EU-03). This is incorrect; Delta Asphalt can use natural gas or distillate oil #4 and the potential to emit for the installation was calculated using natural gas and distillate oil #4. The fuel type does not affect the PM₁₀ emissions from the drum dryer therefore; the composite PM₁₀ emission factor in Attachment A of 062017-002 is representative of both distillate oil #4 and natural gas and requires no revision. Special Condition 4 is being superseded and replaced to allow for the ability to run natural gas and distillate oil #4. Please attach this amendment letter and the following special conditions to the original permit. All other special conditions remain applicable.

If you were adversely affected by this permit decision, you may be entitled to pursue an appeal before the administrative hearing commission pursuant to Sections 621.250 and 643.075.6 RSMo. To appeal, you must file a petition with the administrative hearing commission within thirty days after the date this decision was mailed or the date it was delivered, whichever date was earlier. If any such petition is sent by registered mail or certified mail, it will be deemed filed on the date it is mailed; if it is sent by any method other than registered mail or certified mail, it will be deemed filed on the date it is received by the administrative hearing commission, whose contact information is: Administrative Hearing Commission, United States Post Office Building, 131 West High Street, Third Floor, P.O. 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SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

The permittee is authorized to construct and operate subject to the following special conditions:

The special conditions listed in this permit were included based on the authority granted the Missouri Air Pollution Control Program by the Missouri Air Conservation Law (specifically 643.075) and by the Missouri Rules listed in Title 10, Division 10 of the Code of State Regulations (specifically 10 CSR 10-6.060). For specific details regarding conditions, see 10 CSR 10-6.060 paragraph (12)(A)10. "Conditions required by permitting authority."

Delta Asphalt, Inc.
Cape Girardeau County, S13, T30N, R13E

1. The conditions of this permit supersede Special Condition 4 of construction permit 062017-002 previously issued by the Air Pollution Control Program.
2. Fuel Requirement-Drum Dryer
 - A. Delta Asphalt Inc. shall burn exclusively natural gas or distillate oil with a sulfur content less than or equal to 0.5 percent by weight in their drum dryer (EU-3).
 - B. Delta Asphalt Inc shall demonstrate compliance with Special Condition 2.A by obtaining records of the distillate fuel oil's sulfur content from the vendor for each shipment of fuel received or by testing each shipment of fuel for the sulfur content in accordance with the method described in 10 CSR 10-6.040 *Reference Methods*.
 - C. Delta Asphalt Inc. shall keep the records required by Special Condition 2.B with the unit and make them available for Department of Natural Resources' employees upon request.
