Dear Mr. Steeby:

On August 22, 2017, Air Pollution Control Program received your request to amend Permit No. 012007-004B by changing Special Condition 2 from a National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) limitation for particulate matter less than ten microns in diameter (PM₁₀) to a daily throughput limitation. A new daily production limit will be imposed during solitary and concurrent operations at this site.

As previously stated, the ambient impact from the Permit No. 012007-004B is being converted to a daily production limit. This change reflects the Air Pollution Control Program's updated construction industry policy for the cessation of the use of the program's nomographs to estimate the plant's ambient impact. Norris Quarries PORT-0512 is permitted to operate with other plants located at the following site as long as the following scenarios summarized in Table 1 are maintained.

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If you were adversely affected by this permit decision, you may be entitled to pursue an appeal before the administrative hearing commission pursuant to Sections 621.250 and 643.075.6 RSMo. To appeal, you must file a petition with the administrative hearing commission within thirty days after the date this decision was mailed or the date it was delivered, whichever date was earlier.
