Dear Mr. Strack:

On March 20, 2017, Air Pollution Control Program received your request to amend Permit #102008-007B by changing Special Condition 2 from a National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) limitation for particulate matter less than ten microns in diameter (PM<sub>10</sub>) to a daily throughput limitation. A new daily production limit will be imposed during solitary, same owner and different owner operations at this site.

As previously stated, the ambient impact from the Permit No. 102008-007B is being converted to a daily production limits. This change reflects the Air Pollution Control Program's updated construction industry policy for the cessation of the use of the program's nomographs to estimate the plant's ambient impact. Strack Stone Company is permitted to operate with other plants located at the following site as long as the following scenarios summarized in Table 1 are maintained.

1. **Superseding Condition**  
The conditions of this permit supersede all conditions found in the previously issued amendment 102008-007B issued by the Air Pollution Control Program.
2. **Daily Production Limit**
  - A. Strack Stone Company shall limit its daily production based on the table below using Attachment A, or another equivalent form, that has been approved by the Air Pollution Control Program, including electronic forms.

3. **Concurrent Operation Requirement**  
Strack Stone Company cannot operate with any other plants that have ambient impact limits based on the Air Pollution Control Program's nomographs. When other plants locate to the site, please refer to the special conditions of that plant's permit.
4. **Record Keeping Requirement**  
Strack Stone Company shall maintain all records required by this permit for not less than five years and make them available to any Missouri Department of Natural Resources' personnel upon request.
