RE: New Source Review Permit Amendment - Permit Number: 042010-007B
Project Number: 2019-07-010; Installation Number: 035-0020

Dear Mr. Gibbs

On July 8, 2019, Air Pollution Control Program received your request to amend Permit #042010-007A by changing Special Condition 2 from a National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) Limitation for particulate matter less than ten microns in diameter (PM₁₀) to a daily throughput limitation.

The ambient impact from Permit #042010-007 is being converted to daily production limits. This change reflects the Air Pollution Control Program's updated construction industry policy "Ceasing the Use of Nomographs" dated May 1, 2016.

Van Buren Stone Co, LLC is permitted to operate with other plants located at the site as long as the following scenarios are maintained. These scenarios are also summarized in the table below.

If you were adversely affected by this permit decision, you may be entitled to pursue an appeal before the administrative hearing commission pursuant to Sections 621.250 and 643.075.6 RSMo. To appeal, you must file a petition with the administrative hearing commission within thirty days after the date this decision was mailed or the date it was delivered, whichever date was earlier. If any such petition is sent by registered mail or certified mail, it will be deemed filed on the date it is mailed; if it is sent by any method other than registered mail or certified mail, it will be deemed filed on the date it is received by the administrative hearing commission, whose contact information is: Administrative Hearing Commission, United States Post Office Building, 131 West High Street, Third Floor, P.O. The permittee is authorized to construct and operate subject to the following special conditions:

1. Superseding Condition

The Special Conditions of this permit supersede the Site Specific Special Condition 2 found in the previously issued Construction Permit #042010-007A issued by the Air Pollution Control Program.

2. Daily Production Limit

Van Buren Stone Co, LLC shall limit its daily production based on the table below using Attachment A, or another equivalent form, that has been approved by the Air Pollution Control Program, including electronic forms.

3. Recordkeeping Requirement

Van Buren Stone Co, LLC shall maintain all records required by this permit for not less than five years and make them available to any Missouri Department of Natural Resources' personnel upon request.

4. Report Requirement

Van Buren Stone Co, LLC shall report to the Air Pollution Control Program, Compliance/Enforcement Section by either email at AirComplianceReporting@dnr.mo.gov or by mail at P.O. Box 176, Jefferson City MO 65102, no later than ten days after any exceedances of the limitations imposed by this permit.
