The Missouri Air Conservation Commission has recently revised or promulgated the following air quality plan(s) contained in the Missouri State Implementation Plan (SIP). The following is enclosed for your review:

Inspection and Maintenance program for the St. Louis Maintenance area.

The plan language was revised to reflect actual program operational conditions. The original plan, approved in 1999, was written prior to implementation of the current vehicle emissions testing program in April 2000. As such, the 1999 plan was based upon future expectations. Now that the vehicle emissions testing program has been operational for over three years, it is necessary to reflect how the program is operating. Additionally, the state rule authorizing the vehicle emissions testing program, 10 CSR 10-5.380, was amended to revise areas such as waivers, on-board diagnostic testing and government fleets.

The commission adopted the enclosed plan action(s) on August 28, 2003 after considering comments received at public hearing. The commission has full legal authority to develop the Missouri State Implementation Plan pursuant to Section 643.310.1 of the Missouri Air Conservation Law. The state followed all applicable administrative procedures in proposing and adopting the plan action(s). Enclosed are the required SIP submittal elements for determination of plan completeness per 40 CFR Part 51, Appendix V.
