




All Fund Sources -- All Agencies






Clean Water Fund Sources

- New Concepts
 - Kentucky – 1% of agency budget from gasoline tax
 - Minnesota – Constitutional Legacy Fund from State Sales Taxes (not in handout)


Missouri Clean Water Fees Survey




Legal Basis for Fees & Automatic Adjustments




Domestic Waste Permits/POTWs

- Public vs. private not always identified
- Large range of application, annual and modification fees
- New Concepts
 - Hourly rate for application and reviews for site specific permits (AZ & UT)
 - Population Equivalent (WA)
 - Points System (OK)

Domestic Waste Permits/POTWs – Application Fees




Domestic Waste Permits/POTWs – Annual Fees




* Oklahoma bases fees on a point system

Support for Site Specific POTW Permit Fee Concepts




Support for Site Specific Private Domestic Permit Fee Concepts



Industrial Wastewater





Indicate if the following factors should be used to determine annual permit fees for site-specific stormwater permits (not MS4).




CAFO General Permits



CAFO General permits should be based on permitted animal units or CAFO/AFO Class




Land Disturbance




* Asterisk indicates that fee is based on acreage of disturbed land

Clean Water Fees – Comparison Summary

- Complicated
- Varied combination of application, annual and modification fee
- Most states base fees on something quantifiable in the application
 - Design Flow, Population Equivalent, Acreage, CAFO Class, etc.
