Fee Type	Current Fee Level
<u>CONSTRUCTION PERMITS</u>	
Sewer Extensions - less than one thousand (<1,000) linear feet of pipe	\$75 per Application
Sewer Extensions - equal to or more than one thousand (≥1,000) linear feet of pipe	\$300 per Application
Sewage Pumping Station	\$300 for each Station
Wastewater Treatment Plant if the design flow is less than five hundred thousand gallons per day (<500,000 gpd) - Includes CAFOs	\$750 per Application
Wastewater Treatment Plant if the design flow is equal to or more than five hundred thousand gallons per day (≥ 500,000 gpd) - Includes CAFOs	\$2,200 per Application

>35,000 customers	\$0.40 per connection

7,000 - 1,000 customers	\$0.70 per connection
<1,000 customers	\$0.80 per connection
<u>Industrial/Commercial Connections</u> (excluding fire suppression systems):	
1" service line	\$ 3.00 per connection
>1" up to 4" service line	\$10.00 per connection
>4" service line	\$25.00 per connection
Note: Maximum fee from Industrial/Commercial is \$700	
<u>GENERAL PERMITS</u>	
Land Disturbance - up to 5-year permit paid at time of application	\$300 per Application
General Permit - Other (Car washes, limestone quarries, petroleum storage, metal fabrication, etc)	\$150 per year \$60 per year
General Permit - AgChem (wholesale distribution of chemical fertilizers and pesticides)	\$50 per year
General Permit - Aquaculture	\$250 per year
General Permit - CAFO (Class IB and IC) & AFO (Class II) - up to 5-yr permit paid at time of application	\$150 per Application
General Stormwater	\$150 per year

Categorical ≥ 1,000,000 gallons per day (1mgd)	\$5,000 per Year
Categorical < 1,000,000 gallons per day (1mgd)	\$3,500 per Year
Non-Categorical ≥ 1,000,000 gallons per day (1mgd)	\$2,500 per Year
Non-Categorical < 1,000,000 gallons per day (1mgd)	\$1,500 per Year
<u>INDUSTRIAL STORMWATER ONLY</u>	
Categorical ≥ 1,000,000 gallons per day (1mgd)	\$2,350 per Year
Categorical < 1,000,000 gallons per day (1mgd)	\$1,350 per Year

Non-Municipal < 5,000 gallons per day	\$100 per Year

Non-Municipal 6,000 to <7,000 gallons per day	\$175 per Year
Non-Municipal 7,000 to <8,000 gallons per day	\$200 per Year
Non-Municipal 8,000 to <9,000 gallons per day	\$225 per Year
Non-Municipal 9,000 to <10,000 gallons per day	\$250 per Year
Non-Municipal 10,000 to <11,000 gallons per day	\$375 per Year

Permit By Rule	\$25 per Application
Permit Modifications - Anyone modifying a permit, including transfer of ownership	
Municipals	\$200 each Application
All Other	25% of current annual fee
Permit Variance - anyone requesting a variance to water quality or technology-based effluent limits for their permit	\$250 per Variance Request
<u>Operator Certification Fees</u>	
Initial Exam Application (successful completion includes Certificate of Competency)	\$45 at time of application
Re-examination for same type and level of Certificate (if failed initial exam)	\$20 for each re-test
Renewal of Certificate of Competency	\$45 at time of renewal
Application for Reciprocity (from another state)	\$40 at time of application
Certificate of Reciprocity	\$25 at time of issuance
