Dear Mr. Reppond:

This letter is to notify you that the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (Department) received Safety-Kleen Systems, Incorporated's (Safety-Kleen) Class 1 Permit Modification notice dated September 20, 2013. The notification was to update the contingency plan information within the permit application (Appendix G., Exhibit G-2) dated March 28, 2011. Specifically, the emergency coordinator information was updated to reflect a new emergency coordinator, as well as the addition of an alternate emergency coordinator.

The Department agrees with Safety-Kleen that this is a Class 1 Permit Modification not requiring prior director approval. Safety-Kleen must send a notice of the modification to everyone on their facility mailing list and the appropriate units of state and local government within 90 calendar days after the change was put into effect, as outlined in Code of Federal Regulations 40 CFR 270.42(a)(1)(ii), incorporated by reference in Code of State Regulations 10 CSR 25-7.270(1). Safety-Kleen must send a copy of the notice to the Department.
