

Background Information

The Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program, or FUSRAP, is a nationwide environmental remediation program. FUSRAP addresses radiological and chemical contamination generated by activities of the Manhattan Engineer District and the Atomic Energy Commission during development of atomic weapons in the 1940s and 50s. In the St. Louis area, there are three main sites and associated vicinity properties that are being cleaned up under the program. They include the St. Louis Downtown Site located just south of the McKinley Bridge, the St. Louis Airport Site, and a storage facility at Latty Avenue known as the Hazelwood Interim Storage Site. U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is the lead cleanup agency for the sites; the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is the lead regulatory authority providing oversight; Missouri Department of Natural Resources provides assistance to these agencies.

The FUSRAP St. Louis Oversight Committee is a group of community members who serve a consultative and participatory role in the cleanup of the St. Louis FUSRAP Sites. The Committee provides comments, recommendations, and constructive criticism to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in its efforts to clean up these sites. Members of the general public with an interest in this project are invited to attend and participate in this meeting.
