Dear Mr. Stinson:

Thank you for your September 16, 2013 email correspondence to myself, Mayor Schilly, the City Administrator, Jason Eisenbeis, and City Clerk, Debbie Johns providing update on the efforts of MDNR concerning the Shapiro Brothers facility that is operated by MW Recycling, LLC.

In that correspondence you reference the department's finalizing a report titled "Phase I Site Reassessment" which will describe MDNR's investigation of the commercial properties near the Shapiro facility that were sampled in June. It does not appear that the report has yet been posted to MDNR's website.

In light of this, as well as the length and technical orientation of the three (3) draft "clean up plans", the City and the various residents to whom we have spoken would appreciate the department extending the period for public comment for an additional twenty (20) days. Unfortunately, the ten (10) day period suggested (between September 16th and September 26th), is simply not adequate for the City to communicate with its residents who are affected in this matter and to fully study the draft plans.

To that end, would you be so kind as to identify, by name and address if possible, the Crystal City residents to whom DNR sent out letters.


