
This letter is to notify you that the Environmental Protection Agency Region (EPA) 7 has reviewed Class 1 Permit Modification request, dated January 18, 2011, which is a revision of the original request, dated January 12, 2011. The request seeks to modify the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act permit issued August 11, 2010, (RCRA Permit) to change the operator from American Airlines, Inc., to the City of Kansas City, Missouri (KCMO). The parties have requested the modification as a class 1 permit modification with prior Director's approval.

Based upon our review of Title 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) § 270.42 and other available information, your permit modification request is hereby approved and is effective immediately. KCMO shall provide notice of the permit modification to all persons on the facility mailing list and the appropriate units of state and local government no later than 90 calendar days after the date of this letter as required by Code of Federal Regulations 40 CFR 270.42(a)(1)(ii) and the RCRA Permit. KCMO shall also provide a copy of the notice to EPA.
