The Missouri Department of Natural Resources (Department) received EBV Explosives Environmental Company, dba General Dynamics Ordnance and Tactical Systems – Munition Services' (GD-OTS MS) Class 1 Permit Modification notice, dated November 6, 2012. The notification was for the installation of a second Blowdown Water Tank and NaOH Storage at Building #3.

The Department agrees with GD-OTS MS that this is a Class 1 Permit Modification not requiring prior director approval. GD-OTS MS already sent a notice of the modification to everyone on their facility mailing list and the appropriate units of state and local government within 90 calendar days after the change was put into effect, as outlined in Code of Federal Regulations 40 CFR 270.42(a)(1)(ii), incorporated by reference in Code of State Regulations 10 CSR 25-7.270(1). On January 22, 2013, the Department received a copy of the notice dated January 15, 2013.
