This grant funds the following expenses: Administrative contract for planner (757 hours @ \$18.58 per hour) for \$14,065, executive director (18 hours @ \$26.96 per hour) for \$489, secretary (16 hours @ \$12.95 per hour) for \$207, fiscal officer (60 hours @ \$13.78) for \$827 for total of \$15,588 and fringe of \$7,670, contractual expenses including accounting for \$1,000, auditing for \$1,500, janitorial/snow removal/mowing for \$300; printer for \$150, fax for \$50, software for \$150, office/janitorial supplies for \$200, travel expenses including mileage for \$1,540, lodging for \$900, meals for \$350; rent/utilities/phone for \$1,400, bonding/errors and omission for \$1,550, board meeting expense for \$500, postage for \$195, advertising/printing for \$500, subscriptions, dues and fees for \$3,740 and equipment lease and repair for \$500.

Community Opportunities, Inc. employs over 70 employees including people with disabilities and operates the recycling program.

Industrial Opportunities, Inc. is a non-profit organization which operates the recycling program.

This grant also funds two used bailers for \$400 and a trailer for \$2,000. The project will initially target cardboard at commercial and school sites with drop sites for residents. When funding is available the recycling program will expand to include recycling trailers with compartments for newspaper, cardboard, magazines, paper, plastics, tin etc. for public use.

The grant also funds the installation of electricity to allow installation of lights for winter and evening work at the recycling center for \$4,385. The project funds removal of a hydraulic lift, fluid and restoration of floor for the recycling center for \$3,775. The recycling center was formerly a service station and the removal of the lift will increase efficiency and safety. An additional amount of \$840 is funded for advertising, recycling and DNR logos for trailers.

The Northeast MO Regional Planning Commission/Rural Development Corporation will administer/coordinate six (6) free e-waste collections, one in each county of the District. Withdrawn.

The benches and picnic tables will be placed on the NEMO fairgrounds for use during the fair and other events. The NEMO Fair Board will work with the 4-H clubs and FFA Chapters to produce recycled content market development material information and signage.

This grant will fund the building of an outdoor classroom and include recycling education for the students and community.
