


Common Elements of E-waste Producer Responsibility State Laws:

- Core Group of Products Covered
- Certain Groups/Individuals Get Free Recycling
- Goals or Targets for Recycling – Some
- Includes Disposal Ban – Slightly more than 50%.
- Includes Fee – Most but Not All
