Dear M and M Cattle and Poultry Farm:

Pursuant to the Missouri Code of State Regulations, under the Department of Natural Resources' Water Protection Program and in compliance with the Missouri Clean Water Law, we have issued and are enclosing a General State Operating Permit for M and M Cattle and Poultry Farm.

Please review the requirements of your permit. Monitoring reports that may be required by this permit must be submitted on a periodic basis. Copies of the necessary report forms, if required, are enclosed and should be mailed to the Department of Natural Resources' Water Protection Program. Please contact that office for additional forms.

This General Permit is your new state operating permit and replaces all previous state operating permits and letters of approval for the discharges described within. In all future correspondence regarding this permit, please refer to your general permit number as shown on page one of your permit.

If you were adversely affected by this decision, you may be entitled to an appeal before the administrative hearing commission pursuant to 10 CSR 20-1.020 and Sections 644.051.6 and 621.250, RSMo. To appeal, you must file a petition with the administrative hearing commission within thirty days after the date this decision was mailed or the date it was delivered, whichever date was earlier. If any such petition is sent by registered mail or certified mail, it will be deemed filed on the date it is mailed; if it is sent by any method other than registered mail or certified mail, it will be deemed filed on the date it is received by the administrative hearing commission. 
