

**Statute/Authority:** Statute 644.021

**Number of Members:** 7

**Number of Members Appointed by the Governor:** 7

**Is Senate Confirmation Required?** Yes.

**Membership Composition:** All members shall be representative of the general interest of the public and shall have an interest in and knowledge of conservation and the effects and control of water contaminants. All members shall have demonstrated an interest and knowledge about water quality. Two members, but no more than two, shall be knowledgeable concerning the needs of agriculture, industry or mining and interested in protecting these needs in a manner consistent with the purposes of sections 644.006 to 644.141. One such member shall be knowledgeable concerning the needs of publicly owned wastewater treatment works. Four members shall represent the public.

**Terms:** Four years and until successors are selected and qualified. **Political Affiliation:** No more than four from the same political party. **Compensation:** Reasonable and necessary expenses.

**Geographic Consideration:** None specified.

**Responsibilities of the Commission/Members:** Exercise general supervision of the administration and enforcement of the Missouri Clean Water Law; Develop comprehensive plans and programs for the prevention, control and abatement of new or existing sources of pollution; develop Missouri's Water Quality Standards and administer other clean water regulations; develop Missouri's list of impaired waters; issue permits limiting the discharge of pollutants into the state's waters; decide matters brought on appeal; administer variance requests; take enforcement action against those who violate the Missouri Clean Water Law and implementing regulations; certification of operators of municipal wastewater facilities and the largest Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation waste management systems; oversee financial assistance to protect and preserve water quality; develop the Nonpoint Source Management.

Plan outlining Missouri's approach to addressing nonpoint problems; maintain a Continuing Planning Process that brings together and coordinates all aspects of water pollution control in an effort to assure the state maintains progress toward protecting and preserving water quality.



**Statute/Authority:** Statute 640.100 and 640.105, RSMo

**Number of Members:** 9

**Number of Members Appointed by the Governor:** 9

**Is Senate Confirmation Required?** Senate confirmation is required.

**Membership Composition:** All members of the commission shall be representative of the general interest of the public or of public water systems. Four members shall be associated with the operation of public water systems, one of which shall be associated with a water system serving a population of 75 or less, one of which shall be associated with a water system serving a population greater than 75 but not more than 2,500, one of which shall be associated with a water system serving a population greater than 2,500 and less than 100,000, and one of which shall be associated with a water system serving a population of more than 100,000; and five members shall represent the water consuming public. All members shall have demonstrated an interest and knowledge about water quality, and, to the greatest extent possible, the various associations representing water suppliers of the size classes shall be represented on the commission. All members shall be qualified by interest, education, training or experience to provide, assess and evaluate scientific and technical information concerning drinking water, financial requirements and the effects of the publishing of standards, rules and regulations.

**Terms:** Four years.

**Political Affiliation:** No requirement.

**Compensation:** Members of the commission shall be reimbursed for travel and other actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.

**Geographic Consideration:** None

**Responsibilities of the Commission/Members:**

- Publish rules and regulations necessary for the implementation, administration and enforcement of

sections 640.100 to 640.140 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri

- Adopts the annual Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Intended Use Plan.
- Adopts annually the priority point criteria used for awarding drinking water loans.



256.605 RSMo

9

## **Number of Members Appointed by the Governor**

8

## **Is Senate Confirmation Required?**

Yes

## **Membership Composition**

Four members shall hold valid permits (two of which shall be a well installation contractor, one shall be a heat pump and a well contractor, and one shall hold a permit as a monitoring well contractor and a well installation contractor). Four shall be public members (one shall be a public water supply district user and one shall be a private well user). The director of the Department or his/her designee shall serve as the ninth member. Each member shall be a resident of the state and be conversant in well drilling, completion, and plugging methods and techniques.

## **Terms**

Four years and shall continue until their successors have been duly appointed and qualified.

## **Political Affiliation**

Statute does not address this issue.

## **Compensation**

All members shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses.

## **Geographic Consideration**

Statute does not address this issue.

## **Responsibilities of the Commission/Members**

Adopt and amend rules and regulations pursuant to Chapter 536, RSMo, which may be reasonably necessary to govern the regulation of the well, heat pump, monitoring well, and pump installation industry in Missouri. Set fees by establishing rules that do not substantially exceed the cost and expense of administering the law. Establish rules for contractors subject to disciplinary action against their permit.

**Requirements for Inclusion of Items on Agenda**

Submission to Staff Assistant at least four weeks before the meeting for inclusion on the agenda and distribution of information to the board members for review.

Public is welcome to attend meetings and make comments or ask questions. Meetings are posted in accordance with the Sunshine Law. Board adopts and amends rules and complies with all public participation requirements of the rulemaking process.



### Statute/Authority

Section 278.080

### Number of Members

6 (+ 4 non-voting ex officio)

### Number of Members Appointed by the Governor

6

### Is Senate Confirmation Required?

Yes, for the voting members.

### Membership Composition

All voting members must be farmers.

### Terms

Three years and until a successor is selected and qualified.

### Political Affiliation

No more than four voting members can be of the same political party.

### Compensation

Reasonable and necessary expenses.

### Geographic Consideration

Three voting members are to be from north of the Missouri River and three from south of the Missouri River. Only one member may be from any given state senatorial district.

### Responsibilities of the Commission/Members

The State Soil and Water Districts Commission administers the soil and water conservation districts provided for by sections 278.060 to 278.300. The Soil and Water Districts Commission formulates policies and general programs for the saving of Missouri soil and water by the soil and water conservation districts, giving consideration to the districts' needs based on their character. It receives and allocates or otherwise expends for the use or benefit of the districts any funds appropriated by the General Assembly for the use or benefit of the districts, including a soil and water conservation cost-share program. It receives and properly conveys to the soil and water conservation districts any other form of aid extended to such districts by any other agency of this state. It exercises other authority conferred upon it and performs other duties assigned to it by sections 278.060 to 278.300; and it is the administrative agency representing Missouri in these and

all other matters arising from the provisions of sections 278.060 to 278.300.

**Frequency of Meetings and Location(s)**

Meetings are held approximately six and nine times per year depending on need. Most are held in Jefferson City, but meetings are occasionally held in other areas of the state.

**Time Expended by Commissioners for Meetings and Preparation Thereof**

Meetings take approximately three and six hours. Preparation time is about two to four hours per meeting. Travel to and from meetings depends on where the commissioner lives and can be between one to 10 hours per meeting.

**Requirements for Inclusion of Items on Agenda**

Agenda items are provided to the Staff Assistant. Districts and individuals can request items be put on the agenda as close as two weeks prior to the meeting.

**Public Comment Opportunities at Meetings**

Any interested person can comment on any agenda item or other issue during the meeting. Written comments on issues can be provided to staff or the commission at any time. The program provides comment cards for those wishing to address the commission at meetings. Most of our activities are not formal or legalistic. Discussion is open and encouraged by the commission chair.
